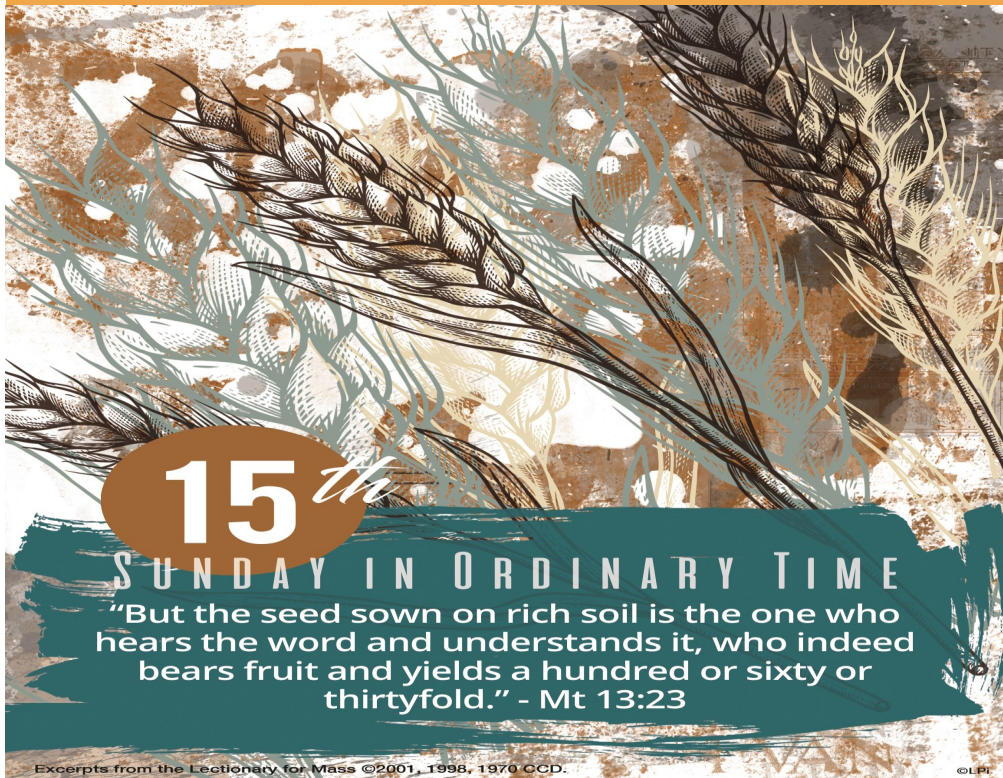

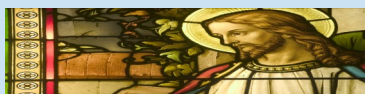

Check Out Churches Online



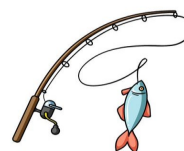
Spend a raining day looking at the different styles of Catholic
