

written in response to one of the phrases that Jesus spoke from the cross. With reflective music and hymns sung in between the reflections, this prayer service is a moving witness of faith to our parish.

As our chosen participants will spend much of the Lenten season reflecting on their particular passage, we ask you to keep them in your prayers throughout Lent as they seek to go deeper with these last words of Christ. Too, we invite you to support them and deepen your own connection with Christ's "seven last words," by joining us Palm Sunday evening. We are confident that you will find this beautiful prayer service a moving way to enter into Holy Week.
