

## Fourth Sunday of Advent

### **A Message from the Pastoral Associate Theresa Fugardi**



#### **The Fourth Week of Advent**

This week, as we light the last of our Advent candles, our faith invites us to reflect upon Love. What is love? Is it the heady feeling of deep attraction? The sense of joy or peace experienced when we are with those for whom we deeply care? It is the movement of the heart when faced with one in deep sorrow, anguish or need? Or is love the action which is taken to care for that person? Human love can take many forms, have varying depths, differ by degrees, but all love - particularly that which moves our hearts to care for one another, is rooted in one unifying and abiding Source.

Scripture tells us that God is love. This is key. It does not say "God loves," but "God *is* love." God exists as love. God loves with a totality that we simply cannot fathom. Beloved sons and daughters, made in God's own image and likeness, all human capacity to love is rooted in this love of God - ever present, ever active in our lives. St. John tells us that we can only love because God first loved us. And, as hard as it might be to believe some days, God loves *us* - delights in us, deeply desires to be with us and became incarnate for love of us. And here's the thing that might just be the hardest for us to wrap our heads around, given our achievement-oriented culture, we are loved not because of what we do or who we are - we are loved because of *who God is*. Freely, unmerited, we are loved by Grace alone.

This magnitude of God's love was made manifest to us in the person of Jesus - Love incarnate - Emmanuel, God with us. Jesus, who willingly relinquished all power for love of us, came to us as a poor, vulnerable infant. And showed us how to love and how to live. Jesus loved all - fully, without condition, without exception. He taught us to do the same and gave us the roadmap: love God with our whole hearts, minds and souls, and love our neighbors as ourselves. Throughout his life, Jesus demonstrated the power of love - how it can heal the wounds of the world, bring peace to troubled hearts, hope to those in despair and freedom to those who are bound. He poured out his life for us all and asked us to do the same, promising to be our help.

Yet how can we love as Jesus did? How can we - in our own brokenness, fear and woundedness, heal the wounds of others? How are we to put down our defenses, remain open to Christ's healing love and be the light we are called to be? The good news is that Christ is continually breaking into the dark places in our world and our hearts, healing and reconciling the wounded and the lost. Jesus is forever reaching out to us, loving us, and inviting us to fullness and life. He remains Emmanuel - God with us.

In Christ we find wholeness, freedom, light and life. Ours is to have the courage to follow, to offer up our "yes" to his invitation. Ours is to remain open, attentive to the moments when we are asked to love the one before us, another imperfect being like ourselves - another soul, walking and wounded. When we keep Christ at the center of our lives, when we answer his call and follow in his footsteps, when we lead with Love, we *can* heal the wounded, one heart at a time. As we welcome Jesus into our world and our hearts this Christmas season, may we seek to become a people of Hope, Peace, Joy and Love. In, through and with Christ we can be the light the world needs.

"Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. ...if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us" (1 John 4:7, 12b).



### Advent's Jesse Tree

The Jesse tree, which looks like the Old Testament lineage of Jesus, is best described as a prayer device for the home, the "domestic church." While not liturgical in nature, it can be used other places, such as schools.

The Jesse tree can take a variety of forms, but usually includes an artistic representation of the ancestors of the Lord and a reflection or meditation. It connects us to the central themes of Christian faith: that we have been made by an all loving God and pursued by him in love when we have strayed and cut ourselves off from him. It helps us reflect on Christ's coming as a man, that he descended from humans, many of whom were not different


