Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today, as we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, we are reminded of the moment when Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the temple, offering Him to God. This act of dedication is a powerful image of vocation—of responding to God's call with faith and trust. Simeon and Anna, two faithful servants in the temple, also bear witness to the beauty of a life consecrated to God, their years of prayer and service preparing them to recognize the Messiah.

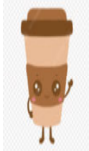

Order of Christian Initiation (OCIA)

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults in the process through which non-baptized men and women become members of the Catholic Church.
