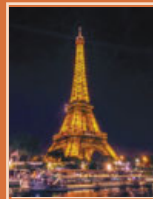

Follow the Way of Love

Remembering Our Faithful Departed in November

Dear brothers and sisters,

Every November, the Church invites us into a special time of prayerful remembrance for our faithful departed. This month begins with two great celebrations that express what we call "the Communion of Saints": All Saints' Day on November 1, when we honor all those who now share in the glory of heaven, and All Souls' Day on November 2, when we pray for all who have died that they may enjoy the fullness of God's presence in heaven.

The Church teaches that we are all united, those in heaven, those in purgatory, and those still on earth, in one great family of faith. This is the Communion of Saints. It means that love never ends; it simply changes form. As members of this communion, we can help one another through prayer, intercession, and especially through the Holy Mass.

When we offer Masses for our departed loved ones, we are not only remembering them, we are participating in the most powerful act of love we can give. The Mass is the prayer of Jesus Himself, the offering of His life for the salvation of all. As Pope Benedict XVI once said, "In the Eucharist, we experience the love that conquers death. It is the love that becomes a bridge between this world and the next."

Pope Francis reminded us, too, that "praying for the dead is an act of faith, hope, and charity." It expresses our belief that God's mercy is greater than our sins, and that our loved ones, though gone from our sight, remain forever in the heart of God.

During this month, I invite you to participate in this beautiful tradition of remembrance. Please return your "All Souls envelopes" with the names of your deceased family members and friends. These envelopes will be placed on the altar throughout November, a visible sign that our beloved dead are present in our prayers at every Mass. You are also encouraged to write their names in our Book of Remembrance, so that our whole parish community can join you in praying for them.

The best gift of love we can offer those who have gone before us is the Holy Mass, the prayer of Christ Himself. It is here that heaven and earth meet, where love triumphs over death, and where our hearts find peace in the promise of resurrection.

May this month deepen our sense of connection with the saints and the souls who await the fullness of glory, and may we find comfort in knowing that we are never alone in faith or love.

Order of Christian Initiation (OCIA)

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults in the process through which non-baptized men and women become members of the Catholic Church. It is also for those baptized in different faith traditions who are interested in becoming Catholic, or for those who were baptized in the Catholic faith but who have not yet received the sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation. These informal gatherings meet weekly, throughout the year, to discuss faith and learn more about Catholic Christianity.

Care of the Sick

Please call the parish office if you or a member of your family is hospitalized or confined to home because of illness. A member of the parish staff or a Eucharistic Minister will be happy to visit and bring Communion.

To arrange for the Sacrament of the Sick or for Viaticum for the Dying (Communion for those in danger of death), contact the Parish Office.

If you have experienced the death of a loved one, the community of St. Rose of Lima extends our deepest sympathies. When arranging a funeral, begin by contacting a funeral home. The funeral director will then contact St. Rose of Lima to schedule the funeral and a time for the family to meet with one of our pastoral ministers.

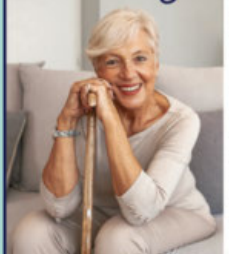
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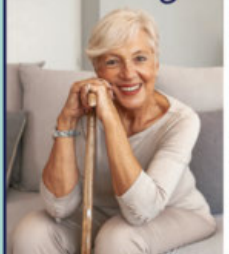
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
