

# **Confessional in the Adoration Chapel**

Rosary beginning at 10:05am is prayed before the 10:30am Sunday Mass

#### Dear Parishioners,

Persecution 2022. Since the time of Christ himself. the church has witnessed persecution. Much of it has come at the hands of rulers and governments opposed or threatened by its teachings or by the efforts to assist the poor. Many recent attacks have happened in Nicaragua, a small country in Central America. This past week, Father Oscar Tinoco from the diocese of Siuna, was arrested and reportedly taken to a detention center in Managua, the capital. The reason for the arrest has not been given. He is the third priest arrested so far this year and the ninth cleric put in police custody. This list includes Bishop Rolando Alvares of Matagalpa and five other priests who have been under house arrest since August 4 on grounds of using media and social networks to carry out acts of violence in order to destabilize the country. In March of this year, the papal nuncio, Polish Archbishop Waldemar Sommertag was expelled from the country. In July, two sisters from the Missionaries of Charity (Mother Theresa's sisters) were also expelled. The relationship between the Sandanista government and the church is tense. Following the re-election of President Daniel Ortega in 2021, the crisis has deepened. There have been nearly 200 attacks and desecrations of churches or sacred places as well as the harassment and intimidation of priests. Bishops have been labeled as terrorists. A special session of the Organization of American States (OAS) met on August 11<sup>th</sup> to discuss the problem and look for ways to reduce the tension. The Vatican observer to OAS, Msgr. Juan Antonio Cruz Serrano, appealed to all to find ways of understanding based on respect and mutual trust in order to find the common good and peace for all.

There are many places around the world where people are treated in harsh and unjust ways. The poor are the most vulnerable to such treatment. Those who try to stand up or change these injustices pay a hefty price. Yet, we must always remember that our founder, Jesus Christ, endured the cross and grave; not because we were unjustly treated or condemned; but rather as an act of love—an act that made us just in the eyes of God. Our response ought to be gratitude. We show that gratitude by what we do for others. When we are mindful of the poor and attentive to those unjustly treated, we are giving thanks to God for what he gave to us. Pray for those who suffer persecution in their service to the Lord. Turn your ear and your heart to those who cry out in need; for if we want peace, we must work for justice...and that justice must extend to all.

Eucharistic Miracle of BETANIA VENEZUELA, DECEMBER 8, 1991 On December 8 of 1991, Father Otty Ossa Aristizábal wascelebrating Mass in the chapel of the Shrine of Betania in Cúa and during the consecration, saw the Host bleeding. The miraculous Host is preserved in the city of Los Teques, at the convent of the Augustinian Recollects Nuns of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, where It is permanently exposed for the adoration of the faithful and It is visited every year by numerous pilgrims coming also from abroad. Many prodigious events have taken place, connected to the Host of the Miracle, among the one which stands out that occurred to a young American who filmed the miraculous Host pulsating like a heart, while It was exposed to the faithful. 
