

# Dear Parishioners,

Surprise! My nephew loved his jack-in-the-box. As a toddler, he would crank the box as it played a song; and then pop! Out jumped Jack. He would laugh and wave his arms in joy. Then someone would put Jack back in the box and he would do it all over again. My nephew always liked surprises. Easter is one of those surprises. Jesus was put in the tomb. It seems there were people who did not like what he was saying and doing. His priorities were different from the religious leaders of the day. He ate with sinners; he healed on the Sabbath; he even forgave people their sins. The authorities were puzzled and appalled by this. It was more than a challenge to their authority. It was a challenge to God. Something had to be done. And so, they put him to death. But, surprise! Jesus jumped out of the tomb. And those who liked surprises laughed and waved their arms in joy.

Easter proclaims that God is a living God and is still alive and well today. When all seems lost, look for him and he will surprise you. Yet, there are many people today who continue to put Jesus in a box. It is not just the atheists or skeptics who doubt the existence of God, but it is often religious people who think they know how and when God will act. Perhaps they forget that God is a living and does not have to act the way we expect. Easter reminds us that God is full of surprises; and some are yet to come. We must leave our minds and hearts open to the miracles only a living God can bring. Life comes from life. That is what the disciples learned as they came to understand Jesus' resurrection. That is what we must still learn. When things are difficult and all seems lost; look for Easter to roll around again. Pop! Jesus comes out of the tomb. Do you like surprises?

**Divine Mercy Sunday**. This week we celebrate the octave of Easter. Everyday is about the resurrection of Jesus. Next Sunday we close the octave with the Feast of Divine Mercy. During the week, a novena prayer will be offered each day before Mass.

**Confessions** are heard Monday-Saturday mornings from 7:30-7:45am and on Saturday afternoon 3-4pm.




