

#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

#### The Quiet Prayers of the Mass (Continued!)

After the gifts are offered, the priest bows profoundly and speaks the following prayer quietly (even if the "berakah" prayers are spoken aloud):

"With humble spirit and contrite heart may we be accepted by you, O Lord, and may our sacrifice in your sight this day be pleasing to you, Lord God."

Notice that the priest uses "we" in this prayer. The priest is always praying not just for himself but on behalf of (for and with) the people. The petition in this prayer is that we, not just the priest but the entire community of believers along with our offerings, would be accepted by God, and that all that we have done and are about to do in sacrifice—the sacrifice of the Mass along with the daily sacrifices that we offer during the "offertory"—would please God and benefit us for salvation.

Then, following the incensation of the gifts, altar, and cross (if incense is used), the priest washes his hands and prays the following prayer *sotto voce*:

"Wash me, O Lord, from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin."

The washing of the hands and prayer asking to be cleansed from sin reminds us of Baptism, where the waters of life cleanse the soul from the stain of original sin. It also recalls the many ritual purifications of the Old Law, now replaced by the one purification of Baptism. These words remind the priest of the purity of life to which he is called, but also asks pardon for any wrongdoing incurred, so as to make him a holy vessel capable of offering this sublime and most holy sacrifice of the Mass.

After the preparation of the altar, the Eucharistic Prayer is prayed, followed by the Communion Rite, which begins with the recitation of the "Our Father." After the exchange of the sign of peace, as the "Lamb of God" is being sung, the priest breaks the consecrated Host and places a small piece in the chalice, saying quietly:

"May this mingling of the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ bring eternal life to us who receive it."

As the sacred species have been consecrated at this point in Mass, the "bread" and "wine" are now the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. Placing a small piece of the consecrated host into the Precious Blood brings the Flesh and Blood of Christ together and reminds the faithful of the unity of Christ's Body and Blood in the work of salvation—that it was indeed through the sacrifice of Jesus' living and glorious Body and Blood that we were saved. It's that very sacrifice that we as Catholics re-present to the Father (N.B.: NOT "represent," as if it weren't real, but literally *re*-present, making present again the *one* sacrifice offered by Christ at Calvary) in offering the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. The priest, in this commingling, prays that that sacrifice would bring to each of us the gift of eternal life.

#### **Mass Attendance Family School Agreement**

To qualify for the Blessed Sacrament active parishioner rate, your family must attend Mass at Blessed Sacrament for 51% of the weeks. Attendance is tracked for the calendar year, so your attendance in 2025 determines the tuition rate for the '26/'27 school year. Each family is asked to submit an attendance card at each Saturday evening, Sunday or Holy Day of Obligation Mass that you attend at Blessed Sacrament. The slip is to be given to the Priest after Mass by one of the children. Please write the name(s) of the parent with whom the child is attending Mass. There are extra slips in the back of church.



Parish School of Religion will begin registration on **September 2, 2025**. The program is designed for families of children attending public schools.






