

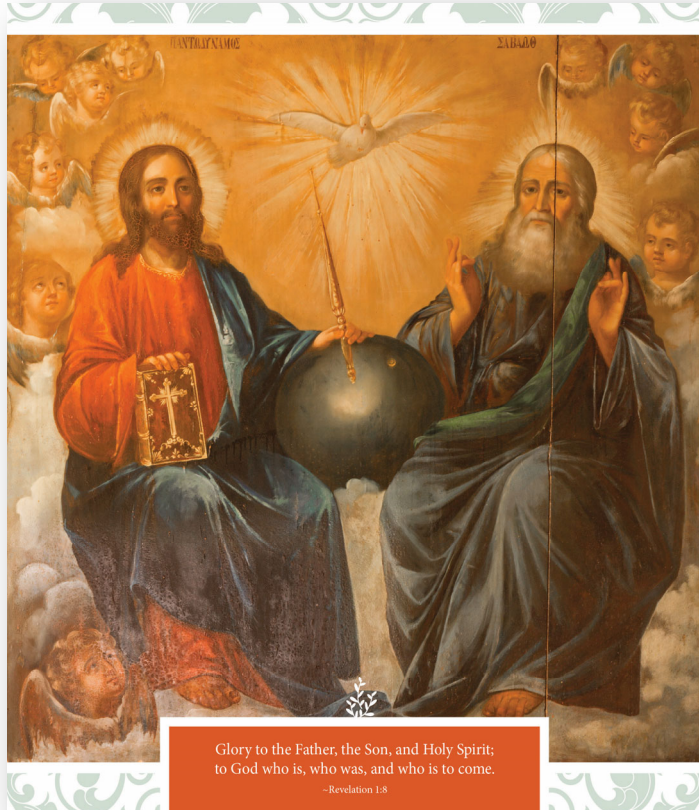

Pastor's Column June 16, 2019



My Friends in Christ:

PENTECOST SUNDAY: THE OUTPOURING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Pentecost Sunday was one of those special days that will go down in the wonderful history of St. Jude Parish. We dedicated and blessed the new Narthex of the Church within the context of our 10:00 AM Mass. I had invited two special guests, Dick and Angie Clark, to join us for this special celebration. They are parishioners of Our Lady of Guadalupe Church, Buckingham. They generously gifted our parish \$145,000 last summer, as seed money for the expansion of the Church Narthex. The gift was dependent on our paying off the expenses related to the interior church renovations that were completed over the past two years. Due to the generosity of our parishioners, we were able to successfully raised the required \$145,000 by Christmas 2018. The Narthex of the Church has been dedicated to the memory of parents of Dick and Angie.

During the dedication and blessing of the Narthex, we also blessed the Donor Board and prayed for all of our parishioners who helped us, either with the "yellow envelopes," or memorial gifts, or prayers of support. I also blessed a plaque that was dedicated to Deacon John Riordan, who oversaw all phases of the church renovations and narthex expansion.

This morning, Dick Clark called me to tell me that he and his wife, Angie, could not stop praising our parish. They were so moved by the reverence of the parish community, the outstanding choir, the joy and prayerfulness of the community and the people who came up to them during the reception to welcome them to the parish and to thank them for their most generous gift.

Our parishioners were excited to enjoy the reception after the Mass in our new Narthex. It is spacious and beautiful. But Not Completed. The inside of the Narthex should be finished by the end of June. The exterior renovations will be completed sometime in the future. We need to install the stonework around the outside façade and add a canopy over the entrance. To ensure that we remain prudent stewards of our parish finances, we will pay off the narthex renovations first (approximately \$101,000.00) before completing exterior renovations.

I remain extremely grateful to the many parishioners who have financially supported our renovations. I would ask those parishioners who have not yet been able to contribute as well as those parishioners I have spoken to who are considering purchasing a memorial gift, to please consider helping our parish complete our narthex expansion. For the remaining memorial opportunities, please take a copy of the memorial highlight sheet at the entrances to the church or view all remaining memorial opportunities on our parish website. I am very grateful and appreciative to all of you for all that you do for the Parish.
