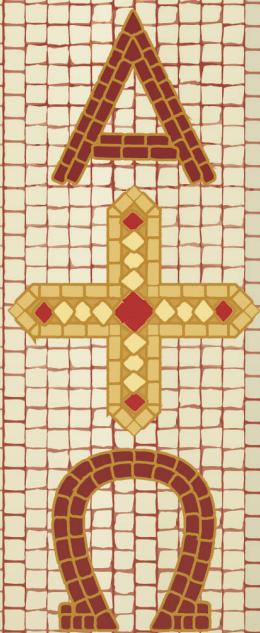

THE RICHNESS OF THE SPIRIT

In the readings on Pentecost Sunday, the Spirit is described as a driving wind and tongues of fire. Knowing that the Holy Spirit is a Person of the Trinity, we may be able to best understand Who the Spirit is in terms of what He does. In our second reading, Paul tries to explain just that.

First, Paul says that we cannot know Jesus as Lord without the Spirit. The Spirit is the way Jesus is present with us today, so anyone who truly believes in Jesus is guided by the Spirit. Anyone claiming to have new knowledge that is opposed to what Jesus taught is not in the Spirit.

Second, Paul acknowledges that the Spirit works in many ways, mentioning different gifts and services in the Church and emphasizing that all these differences come from one and the same God.

The strength of the Church is in its unity: one baptism, one faith, one Lord. But we also draw strength from the diversity of gifts and services that people offer to God. So look at the gifts of those around you, and you may be able to see the Holy Spirit more clearly.

On Wednesday, the Archdiocese hosted a webinar for priests and leadership teams to present the necessary guidelines that we must follow when we return to church.

I know that we deeply yearn to come back to our Church, to worship together and to receive Our Lord Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist. I assure you that we will do all that we can to provide for the safety and health of every person who comes to Church. Over the next week, I will communicate the protocols and guidelines through a video, our parish website, and social media. We will celebrate with great rejoicing our return to the House of God!

Statement from the Archdiocese Regarding the Project Resumption of the Public Celebration of Mass in the Five-County Region

In mid-March, the celebration of public Mass was suspended in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia and the obligation for the faithful to attend Mass was dispensed. Those decisions were not made lightly and were always intended to be temporary measures.

They were made out of necessity for the common good and in recognition of the fact that all of us share a responsibility for the preservation of public health, especially in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic. During this unprecedented time, the Archdiocese has made every effort to provide for the spiritual needs of the faithful as well as the temporal needs of those who benefit from its many charitable works.

It is important to note that Catholic churches in the Archdiocese have never been closed. Local parish churches have remained open for private prayer as well as the celebration of the Sacraments Baptism, Penance, Matrimony, and funeral Masses at the discretion of the local pastor and with respect for guidelines from public health officials as they have evolved over time.

Based on recent statements from government officials at the state level, it is anticipated that the five-county region comprising the Archdiocese of Philadelphia will move into the "yellow" phase of the statewide re-opening plan by Friday, June 5th. As such, it is projected that the celebration of daily and Sunday Masses will resume beginning on Saturday, June 6th.

The administration of the Archdiocese has been working in consultation with public health officials to ensure that such a resumption takes place within the context of state approved guidelines and is actively working to provide appropriate guidance to its clergy so that all will be as prepared as possible when the public celebration of Mass begins again. All of us are eager to open the doors of Church wide for the celebration of the Holy Eucharist.

Guidelines for Resumption of Public Mass and Reception of the Eucharist Beginning Saturday, June 6, 2020



We are grateful to God that we can once again return to the attendance of Mass and reception of Jesus in Holy Communion!

In order to continue to maintain safety precautions, please follow the Archdiocesan guidelines below:

- ♦ **The dispensation to attend Mass and Holy Days of Obligation that was approved by the Archbishop remains in effect for all the faithful**
- ♦ **Those who are sick or who have compromising health issues should not plan to attend public Mass at this time**
- ♦ **If you choose not to attend, please remember to keep the Lord's Day holy by joining us through our live streamed Masses and making a Spiritual Communion**
- ♦ **Face coverings must be worn by all worshipers (age 2 and up) upon entering and while in the church**
- ♦ **Maintain social distancing of 6 feet between families (families may continue to sit together as usual)**
- ♦ **Please do not congregate in the main body of the church before or after Mass at this time**
- ♦ **Guidelines for reception of the Eucharist will be communicated prior to Communion**

And our inmost being fill!

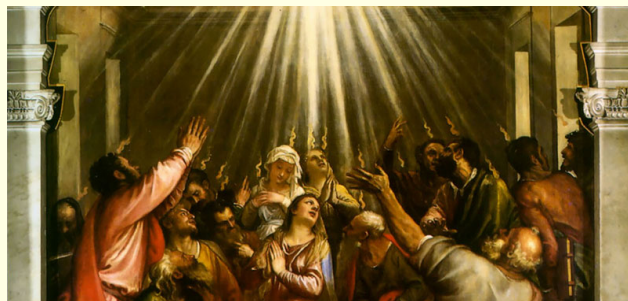
Where Thou are not, we have naught,

Mary Mother of the Church Feast Day June 1

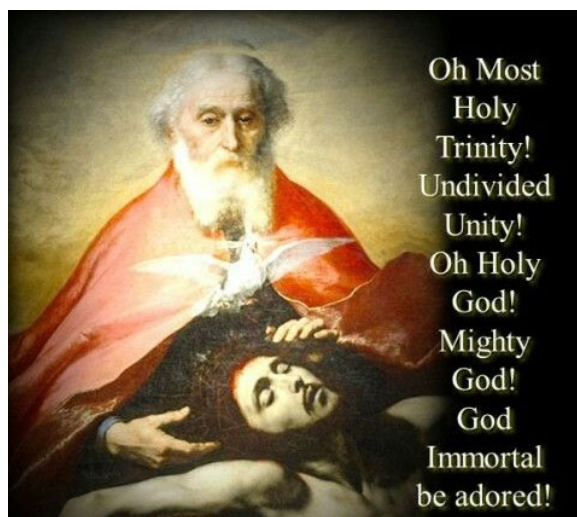

Weekly Discernment Groups

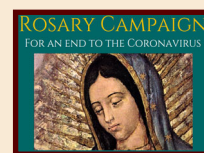

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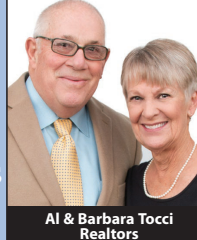
