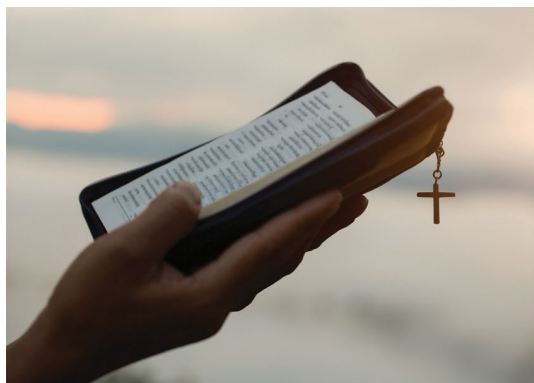

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THE CHALLENGE

Both the first and second readings talk about Noah and the ark, where the few good people were saved by going through the water. Peter compares that to the waters of Baptism, through which God saves us.

Just as God cleansed the world of evil by the waters of the flood, so the waters of Baptism made us into a new people who have clear consciences, both because God has forgiven our sins and because we promise to follow our Him.

That leads to the Gospel, where Jesus is tempted by Satan. But Jesus does not fall to the temptations. Instead, He comes out of the desert, telling us to repent and believe in the good news.

That means we have a choice to make: Do we accept His Kingdom and repent, or do we ignore our Baptism and do what we want? Do we still have a clear conscience when we think of how much time we spend getting to know Jesus?

Just as God's promises get better and better until the coming of Jesus, we are challenged to be more and more like Him. Are you ready to live the New Covenant that Jesus promises to those who will follow Him?

Pastor's Column February 21, 2021

My friends in Christ:

First Reconciliation

Please join me in congratulating our second grade children who received the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time this weekend, Saturday, February 20th. They were so excited to receive God's mercy and forgiveness for the first time in this beautiful sacrament. We were blessed to have a large number of priests, who were available for our children and their parents. I also want to thank Sister Elizabeth and our second grade teachers as well as Mrs. Rawski and our second grade catechists, who prepared our children so well for this special sacramental celebration of God's mercy.

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a communal process for formal initiation of new members into the Catholic Church. This process is a return to the formation of adults in the first and second century of Christianity. Participants "undergo conversion" as they study the Gospel, come to understand the Catholic Faith, enter into prayer, and engage in service to the Church.

Those who participate in the RCIA are called Catechumens – those who are seeking full initiation into the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation) or Candidates – those who have been baptized in a Christian tradition and are now seeking full initiation into the Catholic Church through Holy Eucharist and Confirmation. This year we have one Catechumen (Lisa Marranzini) and two Candidates (Katie Dawson and Layne Szymanski).

As the Catechumens and Candidates begin their journey to full initiation into the Catholic Church, they participate in a number of special events. The first is the Rite of Acceptance, which took place in our parish on November 29, 2020, the First Sunday of Advent. The Catechumens and Candidates were presented to the community during Mass. They expressed, and the community accepted, their intention to respond to God's call to follow Jesus Christ.

The second important event on their journey occurs on February 27th at the 4:30 Vigil Mass. Their names are enrolled in the Book of the Elect and the Book of the Candidates. This marks the beginning of a more intense preparation for full communion in the Catholic Church.

During the final weeks of preparation for the Easter Vigil, they participate in what is called the Scrutinies, which take place on the third, fourth, and fifth Sunday of Lent. The first Scrutiny takes place on March 7th at the 10:00 am Mass. Both the community and the "elect" pray that God will give the "elect" a spirit of repentance, a sense of sin, and a freedom to ask for God's mercy.

On the most solemn Feast of the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday, the Catechumens receive the beautiful Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation, in which they are fully initiated into the Catholic Church and become new members of St. Jude Parish.

Our two baptized non-Catholics will be received into full communion of the Catholic Church during the Easter Season, at which time they will make their Profession of Faith and receive the Sacraments of Holy Eucharist and Confirmation.

While there is much more that can be shared about this most profound and sacred journey of faith and service, I hope this explanation helps to clarify some of the special liturgical events that deeply touch the lives of those who choose to become full and active members of the Catholic Church. I especially want to thank Deacon Mike Cushing and the RCIA team who teach the Catholic Faith and accompany our Catechumens and Candidates on their faith journey. They are so dedicated to the ministry of RCIA. May we all pray for our Catechumen and Candidates.

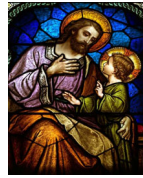

1st Reading – Gn 9:8-15

God said to Noah and to his sons with him: “See, I am now establishing my covenant with you and your descendants after you and with every living creature that was with you: all the birds, and the various tame and wild animals that were with you and came out of the ark. I will establish my covenant with you, that never again shall all bodily creatures be destroyed by the waters of a flood; there shall not be another flood to devastate the earth.”

God added:

“This is the sign that I am giving for all ages to come, of the covenant between me and you and every living creature with you: I set my bow in the clouds to serve as a sign of the covenant between me and the earth. When I bring clouds over the earth, and the bow appears in the clouds, I will recall the covenant I have made between me and you and all living beings, so that the waters shall never again become a flood to destroy all mortal beings.”

Responsorial Psalm

R. Your ways, O Lord, are love and truth to those who keep your covenant.

2nd Reading – 1 Pt 3:18-22

Beloved: Christ suffered for sins once, the righteous for the sake of the unrighteous, that he might lead you to God. Put to death in the flesh, he was brought to life in the Spirit. In it he also went to preach to the spirits in prison, who had once been disobedient while God patiently waited in the days of Noah during the building of the ark, in which a few persons, eight in all, were saved through water. This prefigured baptism, which saves you now. It is not a removal of dirt from the body but an appeal to God for a clear conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers subject to him.

Gospel – Mk 1:40-45

The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert, and he remained in the desert for forty days, tempted by Satan. He was among wild beasts, and the angels ministered to him. After John had been arrested, Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the gospel of God: “This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.”

Penitential Act

Profession of Faith (The Creed)

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

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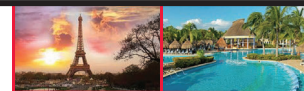
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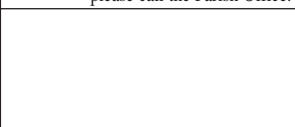
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
