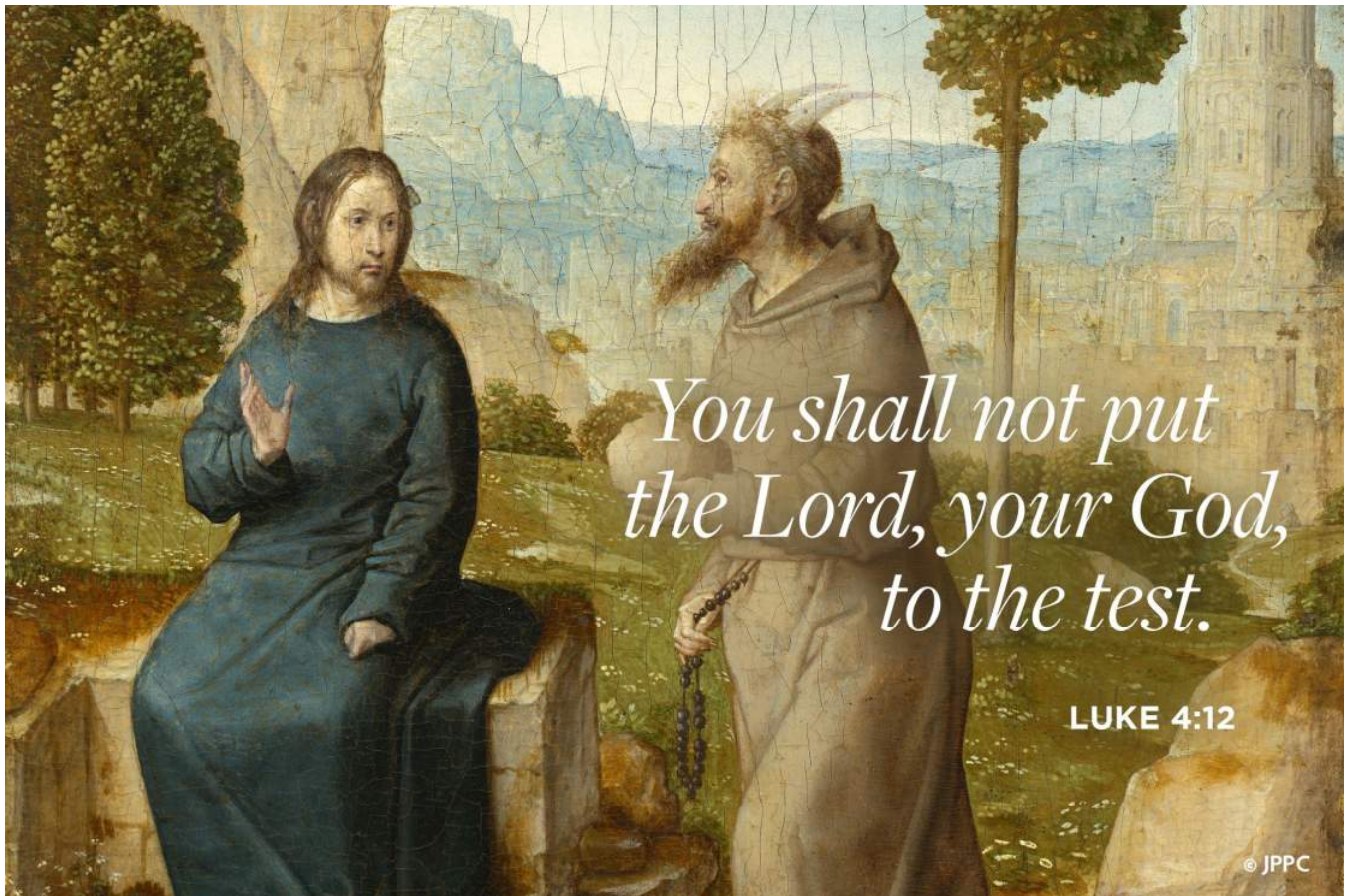

A Message from Our Pastor

On this First Sunday of Lent we reflect on the Gospel passage of the temptations of Jesus in the desert. The temptations were attacks on all that was central to the mission of Jesus in revealing the Father's love. They can also distract us from our mission, but we discover a lot about ourselves when we are tried and tested. Lent is a time for clarification of who we are at the deepest level. During these days we are called to examine where we are and devote ourselves to concentrating on our relationship with God and the temptations in our lives that draw us from Him. Prayer, fasting, and self-denial are tools to focus us on God and His sacrifices for us.

For this Jubilee Year, Pope Francis introduced a new way someone can earn an indulgence by fasting from the internet and social media. He suggests abstaining "in a spirit of penance, at least for one day of the week from futile distractions (real but also virtual distractions, for example, the use of the media and/or social networks)."



Last year on March 10th we were all shocked by the sudden death of Fr. Terry Weik. He had been with us for almost two years and truly enjoyed being with the people of our parish. Fr. Terry also knew that he was loved by you as their priest and spiritual father. Please remember Father in your prayers tomorrow on the first anniversary of his death.

Fast and Abstinence and Other Acts of Penance for Lent

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are 14 years of age and older are bound to *abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday*. Further, all persons 18 years of age and older, up to and including their 59th birthday, are bound to *fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday*, while the other two meals on those days are to be light.

All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to:

- ♦ Participate at Mass and receive the Holy Eucharist daily
- ♦ Celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance
- ♦ Undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures
- ♦ Participate in parish Lenten devotions as well as Lenten education programs
- ♦ Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is especially recommended

All are encouraged to participate in Operation Rice Bowl, which has aided countless hungry persons here in the archdiocese, throughout our nation, and in our world.

Pro-life Corner

The Gospel of Life *Evangelium Vitae*

During the month of March, the Respect Life Ministry will be publishing certain content from St. John Paul II's encyclical *Evangelium Vitae* (*The Gospel of Life*) as well as from his Encyclical letters. Below is an overview of the Encyclical letter dated March 25, 1995.

Present Day Threats to Human Life:

There is a "conspiracy against life" involving governments, international organizations, and the mass media. The latter constantly depict pro-life people as enemies of freedom and progress (n. 17). The policy of some governments to control population growth by force is reminiscent of the ancient pharaoh in Egypt who ordered male Hebrews to be killed (n. 16).



In today's society we hear more than ever about the value and dignity of every individual. At the same time, however, these noble proclamations are repudiated in practice. What explains this remarkable contradiction? The Pope says that personal subjectivity is being carried to such an extreme that each person considers himself to be autonomous and not subject to any objective standard of conduct. People believe that they are free to do whatever they desire and have the power to do. This is an incorrect notion of freedom in which the will of each individual is absolutely exalted and which results in the domination of the strong over the weak (n. 19).

Faith Formation

St. Patrick Feast Day March 17



The future St. Patrick was a Roman-British teenager named Maewyn Succat when he was kidnapped from his native Wales by Irish marauders and enslaved in Ireland around the year 400AD.

Suffering ill-treatment and forced into the fields to tend flocks, he had a great deal of time to reflect and soon turned his heart back to God. He spent most of his time in prayer. Eventually he escaped and returned to Britain, where he became a priest, changing his name to Patricius (Patrick).

In a dream, Patrick saw the Irish people calling him to return to them and teach them about God. He was made a bishop and set off for Ireland around 432AD, where he received resistance from the Druid priests, but quickly won over both the kings and the people.

By his death, almost all of Ireland had been catechized. From Ireland, missionaries spread throughout northern Europe and Scotland, converting millions. St. Patrick and his spiritual children can be thanked for converting much of Europe.

I arise today through a mighty strength, the invocation of the Trinity, through belief in the Threeness, through confession of the Oneness of the Creator of creation.

I arise today through the strength of Christ's birth with His baptism, through the strength of His crucifixion with His burial, through the strength of His resurrection with His ascension, through the strength of His descent for the judgment of doom.

I arise today through the strength of the love of cherubim, in the obedience of angels, in the service of archangels, in the hope of resurrection to meet with reward, in the prayers of patriarchs, in the predictions of prophets, in the preaching of apostles, in the faith of confessors, in the innocence of holy virgins, in the deeds of righteous men.

I arise today, through the strength of heaven, the light of the sun, the radiance of the moon, the splendor of fire, the speed of lightning, the swiftness of wind, the depth of the sea, the stability of the earth, the firmness of rock.

I arise today, through God's strength to pilot me, God's might to uphold me, God's wisdom to guide me, God's eye to look before me, God's ear to hear me, God's word to speak for me, God's hand to guard me, God's shield to protect me, God's host to save me from snares of devils, from temptation of vices, from everyone who shall wish me ill, afar and near.

I summon today all these powers between me and those evils, against every cruel and merciless power that may oppose my body and soul, against incantations of false prophets, against black laws of pagandom, against false laws of heretics, against craft of idolatry, against spells of witches and smiths and wizards, against every knowledge that corrupts man's body and soul;

Christ to shield me today against poison, against burning, against drowning, against wounding, so that there may come to me an abundance of reward.

Christ with me, Christ before me, Christ behind me, Christ in me, Christ beneath me, Christ above me, Christ on my right, Christ on my left, Christ when I lie down, Christ when I sit down,

Christ when I arise, Christ in the heart of every man who thinks of me, Christ in the mouth of everyone who speaks of me, Christ in every eye that sees me, Christ in every ear that hears me.

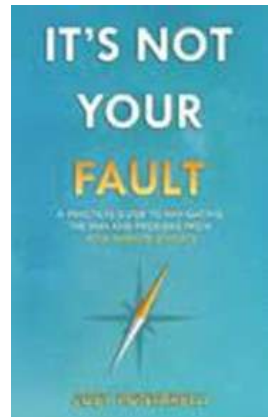
