Two sessions were held, at 4:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m., to gather input from our parish's Boomers, Builders, and Elders about what our more mature parishioners want and need from this new ministry at St. Mark.

Parishioner Jan Cise facilitated the 4:30 session and Mary Lou Morrison led the 7:00 session. Both did a remarkable job of engaging attendees and creating an open atmosphere of sharing and listening. Donna Kern and Laurie Daeger organized this very successful event.

Flip chart after flip was filled by the table scribes and all of this information is being collected and analyzed. A summary will soon be shared with the parish.

Four early programmatic themes emerged from the Listening Sessions:

An "RCIA Refresher Course"...an opportunity to understand changes in the Church and revisit our faith formation.

A Life Review/Spiritual Autobiography opportunity...meeting with other Mature Adults in the parish and writing (and sharing) the story of what God has done in your life.

A "dynamite" social event for the parish's Mature Adults.

A very intentional effort to serve our parish's Elders...those who are homebound and dealing with some physical or cognitive challenges. Home visits for prayer, praying the rosary, Elder Checks by phone, transportation services, and more are planned.

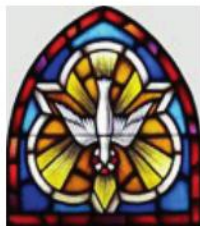

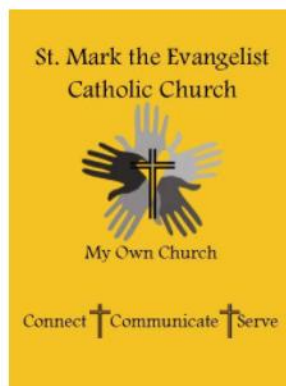

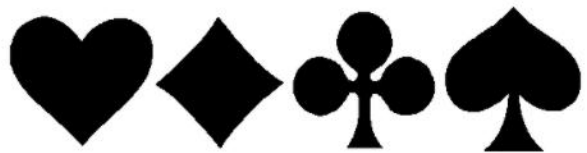
