MINISTRY FOR MATURING ADULTS

Although the aging process has unique aspects, most mature adults face challenges all of us deal with at one time or another. For mature adults these needs are concentrated in a few years and often are in crisis proportions.

Read these words from Isaiah 61:1-3 and learn about some of the needs we, as Christians, are called to respond to:

The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from the darkness for the prisoners, to proclaim the year for the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, and provide for those who grieve in Zion - to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair.

The fundamental purpose of the Ministry for Maturing Adults (MMA) is to make the life of every mature adult in our St. Mark Catholic Church family "better". The ministry will offer (1) opportunities for spiritual growth, (2) opportunities for learning and experiencing new things, (3) opportunities to serve others, (4) opportunities to be served as needed, and (5) opportunities to come together at social gatherings.

With the arrival of Fr. Tim in early July, our MMA Kick-Off Event has been moved to July. We will announce a date for this exciting event next week. Get ready to mark your calendars!
