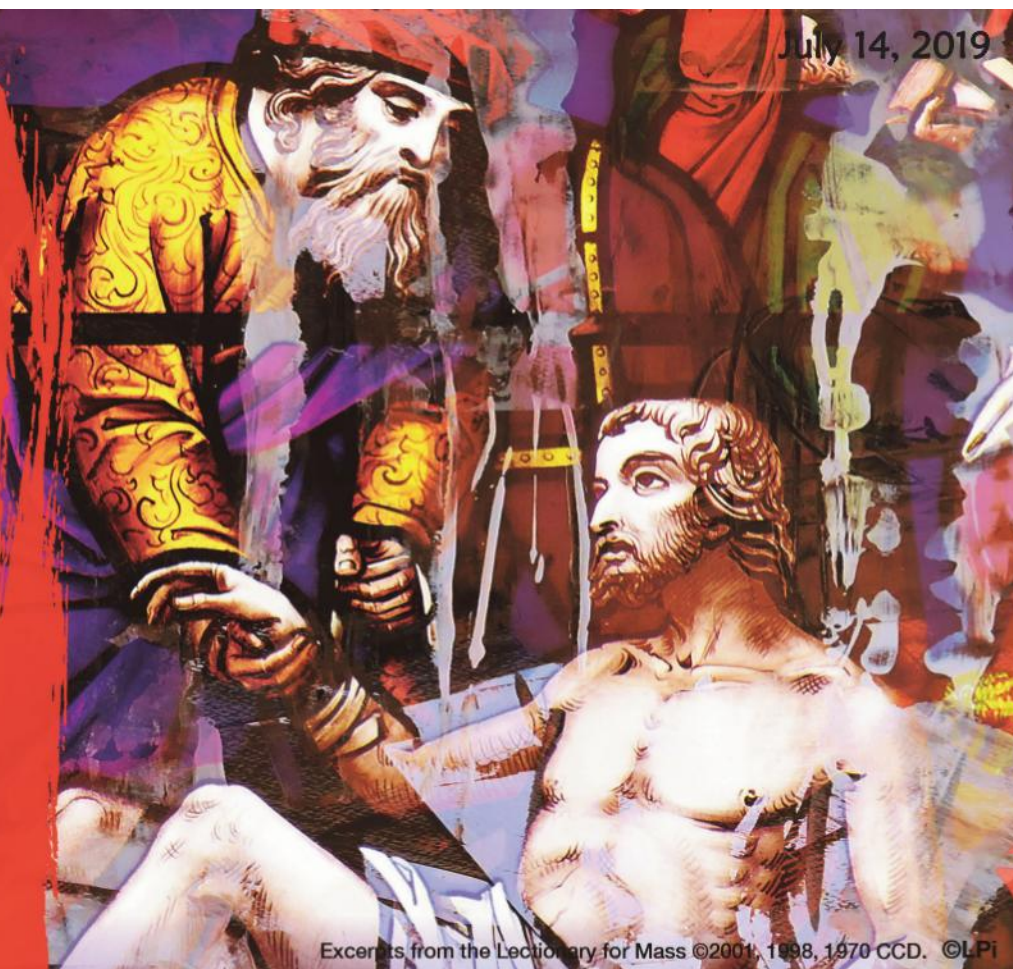

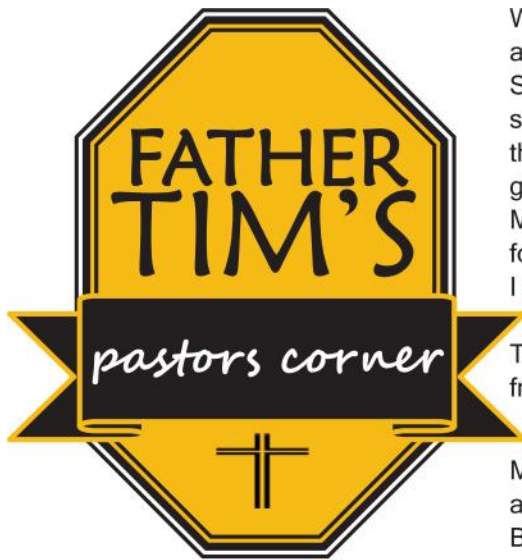

Hello Everyone,

I wanted to take the opportunity this week to thank you all for the warm welcome I have received here at St. Mark! I could not be more excited to start this new assignment serving as your pastor. I figured it would be best to use my first Pastor's Corner to give some personal background on myself as I begin my time here.

First of all, I have always been and will always be a Southsider! I was born the youngest of four in 1987 at St. Francis Hospital in Beech Grove, and grew up in

Walnut Farms (the neighborhood attached to Hill Valley East at 135 and Stop 11). I went to St. Barnabas grade school from 1st through 8th grade and then to Roncalli High School where I graduated in 2006. From there I went to Marian University and joined the newly formed Bishop Bruté College Seminary. I graduated from Marian in 2010 and then went to St. Meinrad School of Theology to finish seminary. I graduated from there and was ordained a priest in June of 2014.

My first assignment was as the associate pastor of St. Malachy in Brownsburg where I served for one year. I then returned to the Southside in 2015 as the associate pastor of Ss. Francis and Clare in Greenwood and Chaplain of Roncalli High School. After one year of that assignment, Archbishop Tobin asked me to obtain a degree in Canon Law. That brought me to Italy for three years, where I studied at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. I finished that degree on my 32nd birthday, June 21st of this year. Along with serving here at St. Mark, I will also work part-time at the Metropolitan Tribunal downtown at the Catholic Center, primarily with marriage annulment cases.

It is wonderful to be back in the USA after three years of studying abroad. I can't tell you how happy I am that I was assigned back on the Southside here at St. Mark! I ask you to pray for me as I begin my first pastorate and please know that you will all be in my prayers as well. I look forward to serving this vibrant and diverse Catholic community and together I truly believe we can continue to make St. Mark a cornerstone of Catholicism on the Southside. If there is ever anything you need from our parish community or from me, please do not hesitate to ask!

Catechesis

Dear Friends in Christ,

Every so often, I am asked to explain what and who are permanent deacons and what are their duties and responsibilities. A deacon is an ordained minister of the Church and the third in the order of Holy Orders, the other two being priest and bishop. The order of deacon was established in the early Church. (Acts of the Apostles 6:1-6.) Deacons in our Archdiocese complete five years of discernment, theological, and pastoral formation through St. Meinrad Seminary. Married men can be ordained to the permanent diaconate, but cannot remarry if their spouse should die before them.



The word deacon derives from the Greek diakonia, meaning "service," thereby, indicating that a deacon is called like Christ to be a servant. The Order of Deacon has three essential functions: the proclamation of the Gospel, the service of the liturgy, and the ministry of charitable works. In particular, the deacon may assist the bishop and the priests in a variety of liturgical functions: Deacons may baptize, witness the exchange of vows and bless marriages, distribute Holy Communion, impart benediction with the Blessed Sacrament, bring Viaticum to the dying, read Sacred Scripture to the faithful and especially proclaim the Gospel, preach, officiate at funerals and burials, and administer the sacramental. In my time as a deacon here at St. Mark's, I have assisted the Pastor in all of the above. Last month I had the privilege of presiding at the marriage of my son in Lexington, Ky.

Within St. Mark's parish, I lead the RCIA Team, set the schedule, prepare and facilitate the catechesis, prepare and conduct the minor and gateway Rites, meet with all inquirers, catechumens, and candidates on a regular basis. I serve on the Adult Spiritual Life Committee and am involved in the newly formed Ministry for Maturing Adults. I prepare, or assist couples for marriage within the parish and parishioners being married outside the parish.

I have two ministries outside the parish, I am assigned to a ministry to the sick at Community South Hospital. I have a certificate in spiritual direction and see 12-14 people monthly for spiritual direction. When needed, I serve as a discernment companion for the Archdiocese connecting those seeking spiritual direction with a director.

I hope this gives you a basic idea of a deacon's and my role within the Church. I am thankful to be a part of the Body of Christ here at St. Mark's and look forward to serving this community and the Archdiocese for many years to come.
