Hello Everyone,

This week I want to take the opportunity to share with you what the other aspect of my assignment will be while I am here at St. Mark. Along with being assigned as your pastor (technically "administrator" the first year and then pastor after that), I have also been asked by Archbishop Thompson to spend two days a week working at the Metropolitan Tribunal at the Catholic Center downtown. This is the reason I was asked to spend three years in Rome to obtain a licentiate in Canon Law so that I could aid the Archdiocese as a canon lawyer at the Tribunal along with serving at the parish.

The Metropolitan Tribunal is the office of the Catholic Center which deals with all the canonical and juridical needs of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. That means, for example, anyone who petitions the Church to declare their marriage null does so through the Tribunal and the case is judged by one of our canon lawyer priests. I will begin my work in this office as the "Defender of the Bond" which means I will defend the marriage's validity against the arguments that it was null in each marriage case. This ensures that every marriage case is properly and thoroughly examined before the judgment is rendered with all sides and possible arguments being considered. Along with annulments (which is certainly the largest part of what happens in this office), the Tribunal and specifically the Vicar Judicial of the Archdiocese, Fr. Joseph Newton, also assists the Archbishop in any canonical matter that he must address. In other words, it provides the canonical legal counsel for the Archbishop when he writes decrees and makes decisions to ensure that all is done according to the Code of Canon Law which governs almost all of the internal functioning of the Catholic Church (from the office of the Papacy all the way down to individual

dioceses and parishes). The Tribunal is a purely ecclesial court and has no function in giving civil legal counsel to the Archbishop.

As it has been decided, I will begin my work in the Tribunal in August and I will be there every Wednesday and Thursday. This means that I will leave St. Mark after the daily Mass on those days and return sometime in the early afternoon so that I can attend meetings or other parish functions in the evening. Because of this, it is necessary for us to move our daily masses here at St. Mark. Starting Tuesday, August 6th, Tuesday-Friday daily mass will be at 8:15 AM. Monday will continue to rotate as a communion service or Mass depending on Fr. David's schedule, also at 8:15 AM. This will ensure that I can get to the Tribunal in a timely manner in the morning and be back to St. Mark for recurring monthly meetings and parish events in the afternoon.

I consider my role as pastor here as my first and most important duty; if you have any questions about any of this please do not hesitate to ask!




