FATHER TIM'S *pastor's corner*

MASS INTENTIONS - PART 1

For these next two Pastor's Corner, I want to discuss Mass intentions (I noticed we have a number of weekdays without specific intentions here at St. Mark). It might have been a while since you have heard these promoted and explained, and I often get a lot of questions about why we do them, and what they are for. There is a lot of history, and a wealth of information about this beautiful tradition in our Church, and I think it can really help enrich our experience and understanding of the Mass.

First of all, it is important for us to remember that we should all bring our own specific intention to every Mass that

we attend. At each Mass, the sacrifice of Calvary is offered for all of us, and so we bring our offerings and intentions to unite ourselves to Christ on the Cross. This is symbolized by the gifts which are brought forward from the congregation to the altar, and by the prayers of the faithful, or "petitions". Along with our monetary tithing and time given to the Church (the offering), we also bring our specific prayers with us to Mass (the intention). This can be for yourself, your family, or for someone else that you know of who is need of prayers; it can also be for any deceased person.

Along with the intentions that all the people bring with them to Mass, the priest who celebrates the Mass also has a specific intention. This is what is meant by the phrase, "for whom this Mass is offered," which we read after the person's name in the petitions. That is not to say that the intentions of each person in the congregation is not also being offered at the Mass, but it does mean that each Mass has one intention that the priest himself offers. This is one of the most fundamental aspects of being a priest: offering the sacrifice of the Mass for specific intentions.

For each Sunday, the pastor must offer one Mass for all the people of the parish (the so-called "Missa pro populo"). For every other Mass, including all of the weekday Masses, the priest can offer an intention as requested by members of the faithful. As has been the tradition since the Jewish priests of the Temple, an offering is made with the intention, and the name of the person for whom the Mass is to be offered is given. Here at St. Mark, Alison Archer, Director of Parish Services receives and schedules these Masses, and in the United States, the current standard offering for a Mass is ten dollars (though you may offer whatever amount you would like).

In our Church, this is the most profound way that we can offer prayers for a specific person, because there is nothing more powerful and efficacious than the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

Next week, in part two of this Pastor's Corner, I will discuss the value of these Masses offered for the dead, in relation to Purgatory and the doctrine of expiation.

Greetings Parents!

It is time for our catechetical year to begin and registration for the following programs begins the weekend of July 27-28th after the Masses. Registration will also be available at the Parish Center as well as the first day of class and online this year.

Children's Catechesis: Our first class is Sunday, August 11th. Ages 3 yrs - K meet at 9:30 am and grades 1st-8th meet at 10:30 am. All classes meet in the Parish Center. Tuition for 1 Child= \$60.00; 2 Children= \$100.00; 3 or more Children= \$120.00. Payment is due with the registration form.

First Sacramental Preparation (Reconciliation & Eucharist):

Our Orientation meeting is Sunday, August 18th from 1:30-3pm. We will begin in Schafer Hall. If your child was NOT baptized at St. Mark, a baptismal certificate must be submitted by September 16, 2019. If your child is already 7 years old and has not received the Sacrament of Baptism, they will be prepared through the RCIA program. Tuition is \$40 per child or \$60 for two or more children.

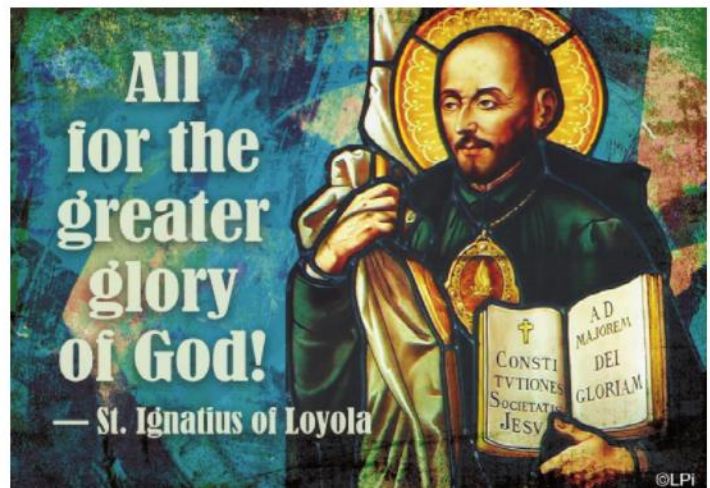
