FATHER TIM'S pastor's corner

Hello Everyone,

This week I want to highlight one of our most important ministries here at St. Mark: our school. The 2019/2020 school year began this past Tuesday, on August 6th, and we are now in full swing. As a pastor, it is an

amazing privilege to be able to see so many of our children being formed in the Catholic faith and educated by top notch teachers and administrators! In fact one of the things I was most excited about when I found out I was coming here (along with finally being back in the United States and being on the South Side) was that I would be at a parish with a school!

It is obvious that Catholic Schools have the advantage of incorporating Christ and His Church into every aspect of the curriculum. The public schools of the South Side of Indianapolis and Greenwood are certainly great academic institutions, but it is hard to overstate just how wonderful it is that in our Catholic schools we can form our students in the entirety of who they are as created by God! So at the start of this school year, let us take a moment to be reminded that St. Mark Catholic Church is one parish and our school is one of our many ministries. All of our activity and life is centered on the Eucharist and all that we do flows from our devotion to Christ. Our effort to educate our children and to bring them up in the faith, is a part of our call to evangelize, and to hand on what we have received. So let us thank God for our growing and thriving Catholic school! And let us thank God for the opportunity as a parish community to introduce the next generation to Jesus Christ and the Catholic faith!

It is time for our catechetical year to begin. Registration will be available at the Parish Center as well as the first day of class and online this year.
