All of our activity and life is centered on the Eucharist and all that we do flows from our devotion to Christ. Our effort to educate our children and to bring them up in the faith, is a part of our call to evangelize, and to hand on what we have received. So let us thank God for our growing and thriving Catholic school! And let us thank God for the opportunity as a parish community to introduce the next generation to Jesus Christ and the Catholic faith!


