

Smells, Bells, and Chalice Veils!

Hello everyone, this week I want to talk about some of the new things you might have noticed at Mass here at St. Mark. We now ring the bells during the Eucharistic Prayer, we use incense during Sunday and Holy Day Masses more often, and the main chalice has a veil over it when it is on the Credence Table. While none of these things are new to the Church's Liturgy (in fact, they are all quite old), it might have been a while since you have seen them! This gives us a good opportunity to reflect on an important concept for our Catholic faith- the importance of external signs.

Obviously, the most important things that happen at the Mass are not visible. The bread and wine becoming the true Body and Blood of Jesus does not

manifest in any visible or physical way. It is a sacramental reality which we believe with our faith, although we can't see it with our eyes. The spiritual nourishment that we receive when we go to Mass and worthily receive Holy Communion is an internal reality known only to God and to ourselves. These are the invisible aspects of the Mass which our faith tells us exist and they are what truly matter. However, that does not mean that we don't celebrate them with visible pomp and circumstance!

It has long been our tradition to try and capture the beauty and majesty of what is happening at the Mass with external signs. Magnificent church buildings, statues, paintings, frescos, and stainedglass are all manifestations of this attempt and we don't stop at our sense of sight. Incense engages our sense of smell as it represents our prayers rising up to God and marks the holy things present at Mass (the altar, the Book of the Gospels, the priest, the people, and the consecrated bread and wine are all incensed). The bells engage our sense of hearing as they highlight and draw our attention to the most important parts of the Eucharistic Prayer (one ring for the Epiclesis, when the Holy Spirit is called to descend upon the gifts, and

three rings for the consecration of the bread and the wine). The chalice veil calls us to consider the incomprehensible mystery of Transubstantiation, which happens in the chalice and on the paten during Mass. There is a long tradition in the Church of veiling that which is beautiful, mysterious, and life-giving. This is where chapel veils or mantillas, tabernacle veils, and chalice veils come from.

I have been very moved by the devotion to the Mass that the parishioners here at St. Mark have shown me since I have arrived here. And it is my hope that every Mass is a moving and profound experience of worship and prayer for all who are present. One of the great things about the Catholic Church is that it acknowledges that we are human beings and so every external reminder of an inward reality helps us in our faith!

THE IMPORTANCE OF THE SPONSOR IN THE RCIA

Each year we have inquirers into the Catholic faith who decide to enter into a more formal period of learning about the faith and entering into a relationship with the



community. Most people who enter this stage of the RCIA go on to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist at Easter. Each catechumen (unbaptized) or candidate (baptized in another faith tradition) is assigned a sponsor from within the St. Mark's community. A sponsor acts as a "spiritual companion" who is open and willing to share their own faith. A sponsor generally attends the teaching sessions with their candidate and participates in special liturgical celebrations both inside and outside the parish. Being a RCIA sponsor is a rewarding and spiritually enriching experience.
