Hello Everyone,

As I spoke in my homily last week about the importance of handing on the faith to our children, I thought it would be an opportune time to write a bit about this in the Pastor's Corner for this week. After all, one of the most important aspects of discipleship in the Church is evangelization. For parents, the first and most important opportunity for evangelization is their children!

Evangelizing your children may seem like an obvious thing. But in our current culture we often overlook how important it is to be intentional about this. It may be the case that the parents of today grew up in strong Catholic households. They might have prayed the rosary as a family, weekly Mass attendance could have been obligatory, and the moral

teachings of the Church could have been strongly instilled in them. However, while this may have been the case for many of our parents, it is not necessarily being carried forward with their own children. The problem here is that there is really no such thing as spiritual grandchildren, only spiritual children! We are only ever one generation away from losing so much of the practices and traditions of our faith. The culture of today is far different than the culture of the past. In many ways, what could be taken for granted in the propagation of the faith to the next generation can no longer be assumed. If it doesn't happen at home from parent to child, it will not happen.

I do not bring this up to alarm or shame anyone, but I hope that it is a reminder to us and an opportunity to recommit ourselves to passing on the faith to our children. This must begin at home. Teaching our children to pray, both the traditional Catholic prayers and extemporaneously, along with taking them to Mass EVERY SUNDAY AND HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION is vital. This is how they learn how important these things are. Teaching our children the doctrine of the Faith by ensuring they are receiving catechesis (either in a

Catholic school, during Sunday school, or both!) is also very important. These teachings must be supported and exemplified at home.

The simple truth is if we are not intentional about forming our children as Disciples of Christ, we cannot expect them to carry on the faith. That is not to say that some will drift away despite our best efforts and in those cases we must never stop praying. The wonderful thing about St. Mark is how many opportunities our parents have to be helped in this, their most important duty. Our liturgies are beautiful; our school has a strong Catholic identity thanks to our principal Rusty Albertson and his staff; and our Director of Faith Formation, Angi Swiezy, does a wonderful job with her volunteers teaching the faith to our young people. Our adults will have many opportunities to strengthen their own faith with adult catechesis throughout the year. There is simply no excuse for us not to form a new generation of strong disciples. So let us commit to this very task!



Daily Mass Sacristans

Prior to mass: turn on the lights and sound system in church, prepare the alter with the gifts of bread and wine in the sacred vessels, and light the candles.

During mass: proclaim the first reading, the responsorial psalm, petitions for the day, and assist the celebrant in the distribution of Holy Communion.

After mass: clean the sacred vessels, extinguish the candles, and turn off the lights and sound system.

St. Mark Children's Choir: All St.


