I feel like I could almost settle, but now it is time for returning home.

I thank God for sending me here to participate in his mission. I give special thanks to Archbishop Charles Thompson, my wonderful pastors: Fr. Jim Farrel, Fr. Tim Wyciskalla, Fr. Bill Marks, Fr. Todd Riebe, and Fr. Hunter who have been guiding and supporting me in every aspect of my ministry while I am here. I also am thankful to our parish office staffs of St. Pius X and St. Mark the Evangelist who make my life much easier in carrying out my duties. I am so grateful to all the parishioners of St. Mark who are so compassionate and patient with me, inspire me with their strong faith, encourage me with their kind words, and generously share with me their gifts. I am also thankful to the Myanmar community to whom I feel most at home with. The longer I stayed the more we got to know about one another and the stronger we could build our relationship. I will never forget the faces of those parishioners who come to daily Mass. Their strong faith always strengthens my priestly vocation.

I am sure I have received more than I gave over the last three years. I have learned a lot about running a good system for the parish—the plans, the functioning and so on. I will have the privilege to share them with my diocese. All are amazing.

Thank you again to all of you and continue to pray for me and our people in Myanmar. I will pray for you to continue your good apostolate works and keep developing a strong faith. For we all are coworkers in God's vineyard and our ultimate goal is to be with God in Heaven.

MINISTRY FOR MATURING ADULTS

This past April, Ministry for Maturing Adults (MMA) held two "listening sessions" in Schafer Hall. Around 100 parishioners, ages 55 and older, came together to share their thoughts as to how this new ministry might best serve them. These attendees helped determine which programs and activities would be offered in the early days of MMA.

There were not many Elders at the April listening sessions so MMA is going to take steps to communicate directly with the folks in our parish who, for this purpose, will be those 80 years of age and over.

On the mornings of December 17th and 18th, members of the MMA Steering Committee will be making telephone calls to the 114 Elders on the parish roster. We hope our Elders will answer the phone and be willing to spend 5-8 minutes to help MMA better understand how to effectively serve this very important segment of our St. Mark Parish.

The phone conversation will go generally as follows:

- The MMA volunteer will introduce themselves and describe that the purpose of the call is to help MMA better understand how to effectively serve the Elders at St. Mark.
- The caller will verify the name of the person being called, will verify if this is the best number to call, and will verify address and residence information.
- The caller will ask the parishioner about congregational care that would be desired, i.e., pastoral visit/prayer, Holy Communion, transportation assistance, lay visit, and parish information.
- 4. The caller will ask how MMA and the parish might assist the parishioner with their life at this point in time.
- The caller will be informed of any available activities/solutions currently in place that might respond to things brought up in #4 above.
- The caller will ask if the Elder uses email and/or text and what their preferred method of future communication would be.
- The caller will ask the Elder if there is anything else about MMA or the parish they'd like to share.

MMA looks forward to sharing results of these phone call interviews in the near future!


