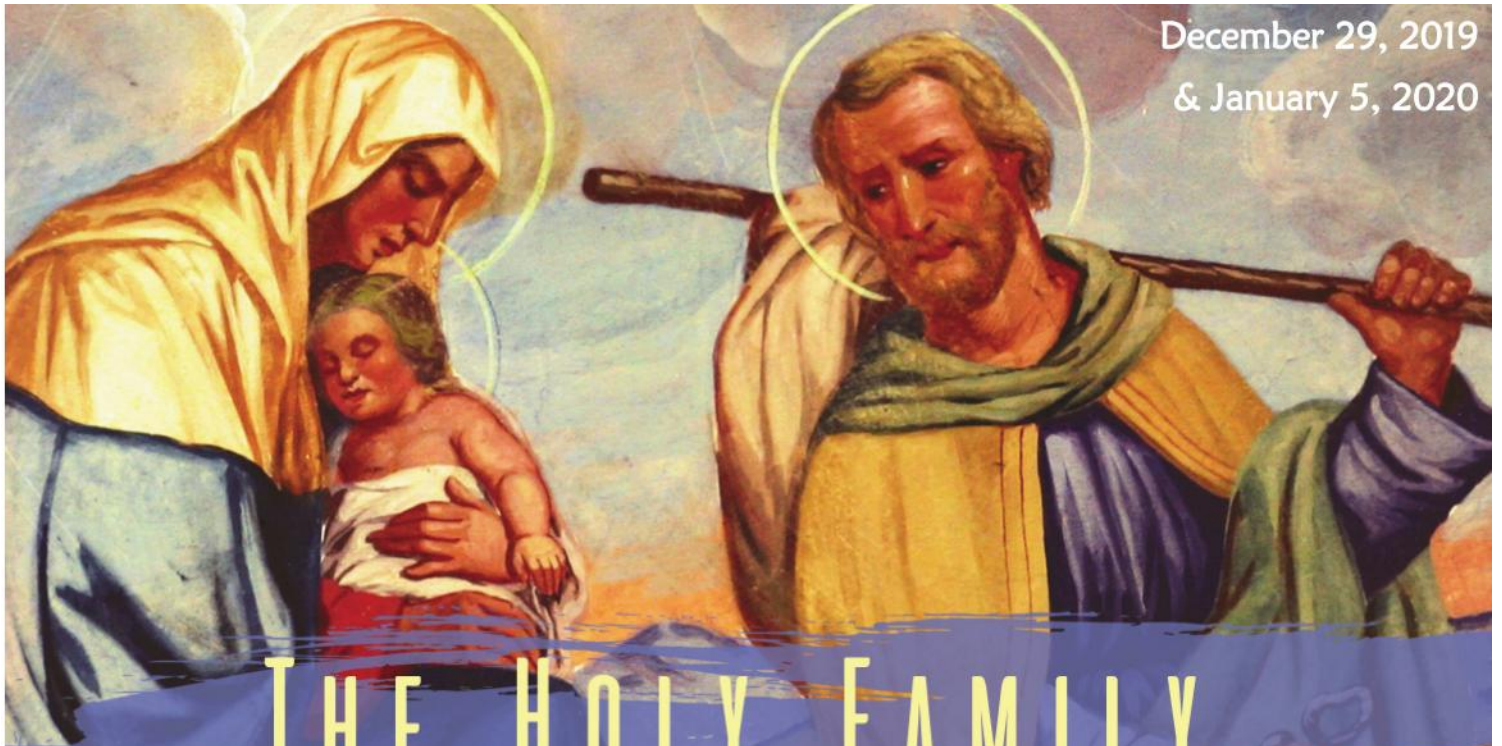

The year 2020 is just a few days away. It's customary at the beginning of a new calendar year to make a few resolutions, generally meant to improve our lives or the lives of others. Time to take stock and promise ourselves to make some positive changes. Resolutions like spending more time with our family, losing weight (I make this one every year), learning a foreign language, getting organized, making new friends, spending less money, or finishing a degree can all enhance to our physical, mental and emotional wellbeing if we stick with them.

Just as important, even more so, is doing something positive this year to grow in our relationship with God and to deepen our personal spirituality. In that spirit, would you permit me to offer you a few suggestions for some New Year's Spiritual Resolutions?

1. Make a morning offering. Begin each day with a brief prayer. Thank God for the beginning of a new day. Ask for grace to live out your faith, to preach the Gospel by your actions, and to see and love Christ in every person you meet.
2. If you don't attend daily Mass, try to make at least one a week. If you already are doing so, try to add a day.
3. Commit some time to personal prayer each day. The Anglican theologian, C.S. Lewis said, "I don't pray because it changes God, I pray because it changes me." Prayer is all about relationship. The Holy Spirit is constantly inviting us into

intimacy with the One who made us out of love, for love, for Himself alone. Pray every day whenever and wherever you can. It will change your life.

4. Spend some time with your Bible once a week. The Gospels and the Psalms are a rich treasure trove of spiritual wisdom and insight. Lectio Divina (Divine Reading) is an ancient tradition within the Church, a way of listening for God in the texts of sacred scripture.
5. Find one thing you can do to serve God's people. Christ came as a Servant and we are called to model our lives on his own. The St. Mark website lists all the ministries within the parish. There are many opportunities to be of service in the wider community as well. If you are not involved in ministry, consider what you might do to show Christ's Servant Love to others.
6. Make a retreat day or weekend. In this busy world, slowing down is definitely good for the soul. Both Fatima Retreat House and Benedict Inn offer excellent programs or you can simply go out for the day on your own.
7. Fast or abstain (from meat) one Friday a month. Fridays are still considered penitential days. Fasting or abstinence are physical reminders of our need for repentance and our solidarity with those who lack food or other basic needs. Consider donating the cost of a meal or two each month to Food for the Poor.

8. Go to Confession more often, once a month or once every quarter. A good examination of conscience leads us to self knowledge, so that we see ourselves more clearly. The grace of the Sacrament strengthens us to overcome our weaknesses and vices. And there are hardly more meaningful words than "I absolve you from your sins, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." It is Christ who speaks through the minister of the Church.
9. Take time to rest from your labors. We have lost our sense of making the Sabbath a holy day. We often feel guilty if we're not doing something all the time. Try to spend at least part of the day each week, to simply be, to be present to yourself, to family, and friends and to God, who rested himself on the seventh day of creation.

There are many other New Years Spiritual Resolutions that you may think of. The most important thing is to make one or two, and stick with them. As a spiritual director, I'm always humbled and in awe of how God speaks to and draws each person into his heart of Love through all the circumstances and relationships in their lives. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Listen to how the Holy Spirit may be speaking to you this New Year. Show up! God will do the rest!

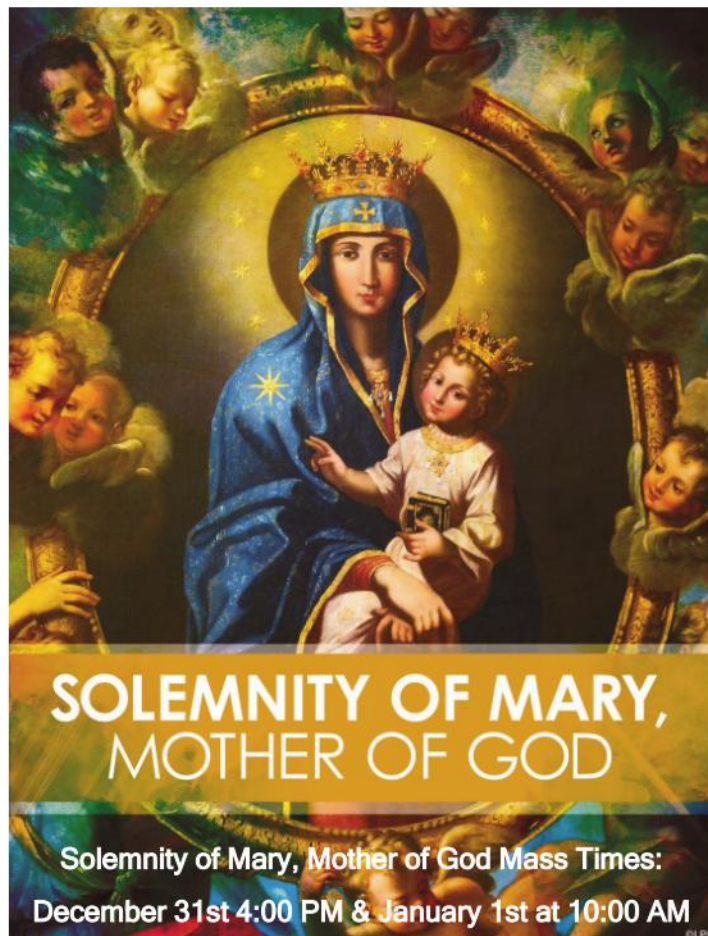

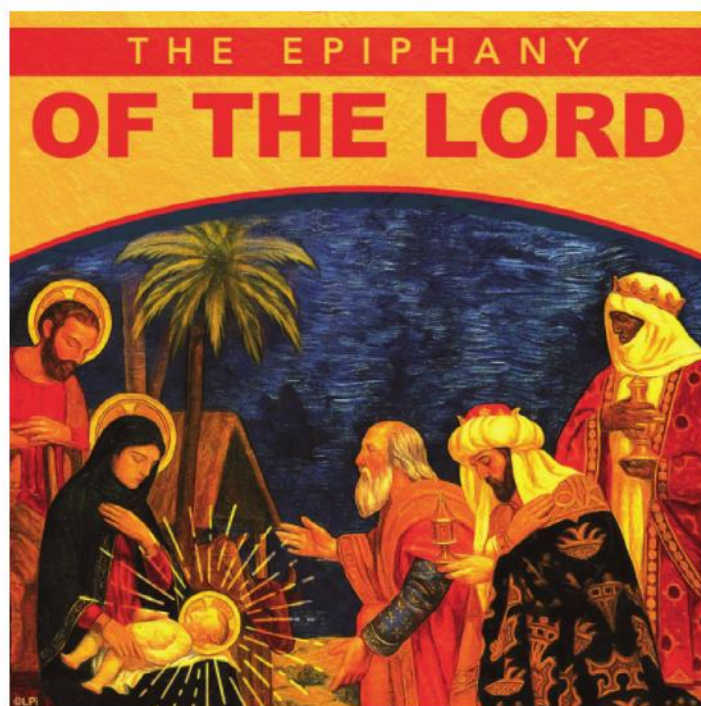
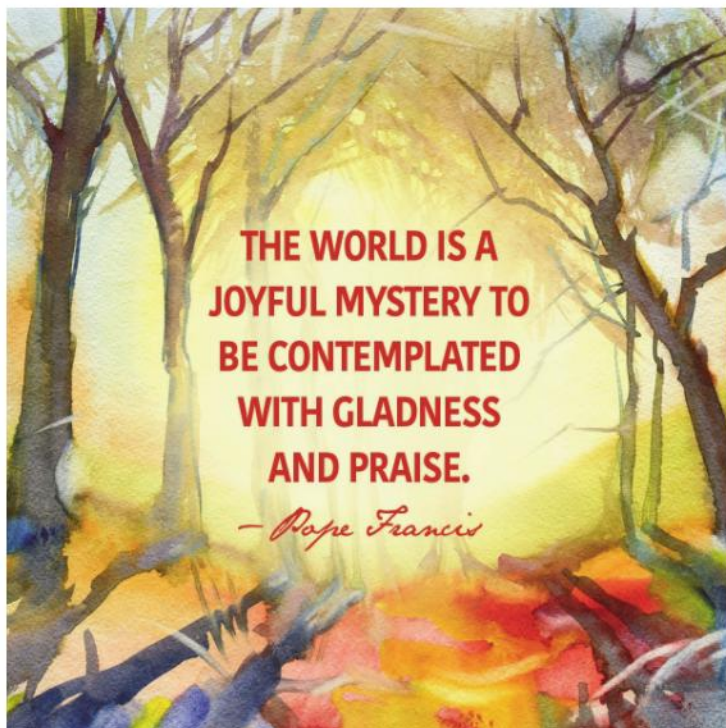
