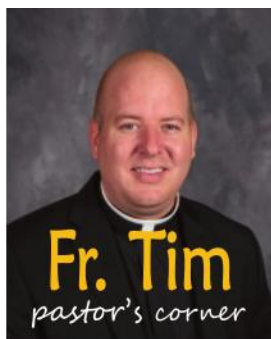

Hello Everyone,

I just wanted to take a moment and thank everyone who participated in this year's United Catholic Appeal. This important annual appeal ensures that our Archdiocese can continue to fund and operate Catholic Charities, the office of Faith Formation, the office of Catholic Education, Seminarian

Education, and our program for Clergy Care. Our parish goal for this year was \$82,180 in contributions and pledges to the UCA.

I am very happy to announce that so far we have pledged \$93,503! That is 114% of our parish goal. Of this amount, \$36,555 has already been received. What is even more impressive to me is that after only two months we are now at 20% of parish households participating in this appeal. This is a substantial increase from last year when after 8 months our parish raised \$82,032 for the UCA with a parish participation of 16%.

It never ceases to amaze me that even in the midst of all the adversity the Catholic Church is facing in the world and popular culture, our faithful continue to step

up and witness to the importance of stewardship, charity, and the Truth that we find in Jesus Christ and His Church. We know this adversity in an acute way here in our south deanery, where our local Catholic high school is constantly under attack by a biased and often misrepresenting local media. Nevertheless, here at St. Mark our vibrant and diverse parish continues to grow and buck the narrative that the Catholic Church is on the decline. Our parishioners continue to show an incredible generosity and zeal for ministry. This gives me great hope about our future, especially, as we look towards the future with important strategic planning and possible expansion in 2020!

I want to end by thanking our St. Mark Stewardship Committee which was responsible for promoting and planning our informational events for the United Catholic Appeal. This committee consists of Carol Pitzer, Tim Ohime, Gayla Aspromonte, Nathan Campbell, and Chuck Kern. Stewardship is an integral aspect of the health and vibrancy of any parish. We are lucky to have a committed group of parishioners whose goal is to highlight and grow the many opportunities St. Mark has for the people of God to participate in the life of the Church!

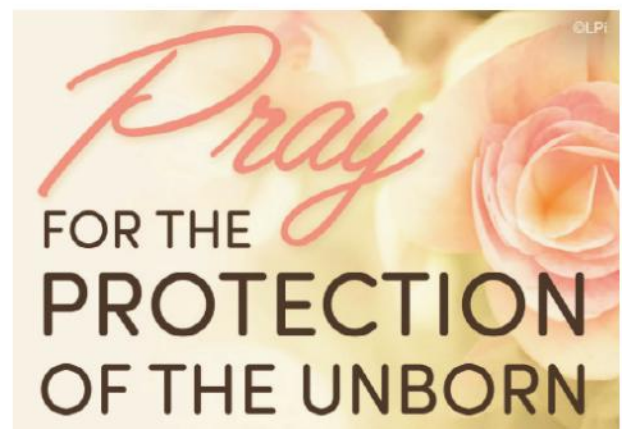
