



Hello Everyone. I want to take this opportunity to thank Fr. Justin Duvall for being with us here at St. Mark this weekend for our Bruté Sunday. This is an incredible opportunity for us to support our local College Seminary, where we have two parishioners, Khui Shing and Khaing Thu, currently studying. In light of this, I would like to share a short article I wrote for Bishop Bruté's quarterly publication about my time there as a seminarian:

When I entered the seminary in the fall of 2006, I had very little idea of where God would lead me in the years to come. I had reached a point where I realized that I would not be able to truly discern if I was being called to the priesthood outside of the seminary. And so, as an 18-year-old fresh out of high school, I enrolled at Marian University and joined the newly formed Bishop Bruté College Seminary. After four years in 2010, I graduated from Marian and left Bruté a very different person!

One of the most important aspects of the college years of one's life is the fact that it is the transition period from adolescence to adulthood. A college student certainly must grow in knowledge and gain an academic degree, but this is only one aspect of the formation necessary to truly enter maturity as a young man or woman. The most valuable aspects of being a seminarian at Bishop Bruté, at least for me, was the spiritual and human formation that went along with the academic formation that was taking place at Marian. Through the daily schedule of Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours, the weekly schedule of formation conferences and Reconciliation opportunities, and the yearly schedule of retreats and discernment events, I was able to mature in the faith as a Catholic adult in an incredible way. The community of other seminarians who grew together, struggled together,

and supported each other, allowed for an incredible amount of human formation during some of the most important formative years of my life. Bruté was then, as I know it to be now, a very balanced and "normal" place. Nothing was too extreme; mistakes could happen, and growth could take place in a healthy, yet accountable setting. The intentionality of all this, guided by the formation and spiritual directors on staff, made Bishop Bruté an outstanding place to attain a college degree, discern my call to the priesthood, grow in my relationship with Christ and His Church, and become a man. I know that can seem a bit overstated or trite, but it is absolutely true. Even if I had decided not to pursue major seminary and priesthood after college, I would still be grateful and much better off for my four years at Bruté.

As it turned out, Christ did end up leading me to Saint Meinrad for major seminary and four more years of formation after college. I was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Indianapolis in June of 2014. For the first two years of my priesthood, I was an associate pastor and eventually a high school chaplain. After that, my next three years of priesthood were spent in Rome, pursuing a license in Canon Law in the heart of our Catholic Church. Like I said, I never would have predicted where God had led me during those first five years as a priest! Now I am just beginning my current assignment as pastor of St. Mark the Evangelist Catholic Church in Indianapolis while also serving in the Metropolitan Tribunal of the Archdiocese. The relationships gained, the lessons learned, and the growth achieved during my time at Bruté have guided me through four years of major seminary, two years as an associate pastor, and three years of university in a foreign country. I am certain it will continue to guide me as a pastor and a canon lawyer now! Whatever this next chapter brings, I am grateful that I have the foundation that I gained from Bishop Bruté College Seminary.

- •establishing an explicit affiliation with one's own age group
- ·meeting social and specific obligations
- ·establishing satisfactory living arrangements

The degree to which maturing adults successfully work through these stages of aging and other life issues is generally the degree to which they experience these later years of life as positive and growth-producing.
