

Hello Everyone,


As you are probably aware, during Lent we are offering a chance for spiritual growth each and every Sunday leading up to Easter. The bi-fold schedule that we gave out after the Masses the last few weekends has all the information about these Sunday events. This Sunday, we have our Tri-Parish Mission at St. Roch. This will be a

wonderful opportunity to learn more about an incredibly important relic in our Church, the Shroud of Turin. I highly encourage you all to attend this mission, starting on Sunday in the church at St. Roch at 7:00pm.

I also want to draw your attention to our Sunday offering next week: Eucharistic Adoration with Benediction. The 11:45am Mass on March 15th will end with the exposition of the Eucharist in the monstrance (the golden vessel for displaying the Eucharist when it is exposed outside of Mass and outside the tabernacle). There will be time for quiet prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament until 3:00pm. About 10 minutes before the end of Adoration at 2:50pm, we will have Solemn Benediction with the Blessed Sacrament, For anyone who has not experienced this. I invite you to come and take part in the final hour of adoration on Sunday (from 2-3pm). This tradition of a Holy Hour in the presence of the Eucharist ending with a blessing directly from Christ Himself in His Sacramental presence is one of the most powerful forms of prayer that we can partake in outside the Mass itself. I hope

you are able to join us for this on the 15th, either for the first time or for the first time in a long time. There are few things that renew our devotion to the Eucharist more than adoration!



Parish Life



Join other St. Mark parishioners for a day-long pilgrimage to the Shrine of Christ's Passion in St. John. Indiana. The Shrine is set on 30 acres and contains forty life-sized bronze sculptures within gardens that have been created to represent the Holy Land.

This pilgrimage will be a profound way to prepare for Holy Week which includes the celebrations of Palm Sunday and The Sacred Triduum (the three days encompassing Holy Thursday sunset to Easter Sunday sunset). The cost is \$75 for this pilgrimage and includes luxury motor coach, meals, and more.

Members of the MMA Steering Committee will be in the narthex after each of the masses this week-end and next to take registrations for this special pilgrimage.

Members of the MMA Steering Committee will continue to reach out to make telephone calls to St. Mark Elders. Elders are those in our parish who are 80 years of age and older. A survey was undertaken several years ago at a Catholic parish here in central Indiana. The survey objective was to identify the unmet needs and services within the parish. One woman responded with a single sentence: "I am eighty-six years old, and my opinions don't matter."

The one sentence contained a multitude of issues:

- the marginalization of older adults
- •the way they have internalized the attitudes that cause
- •their lack of voice and, above all, the existence of those conditions in a parish context

MMA exists at St. Mark to respond in a positive way to these issues.


