Hello Everyone,

I would like to make you aware of the decision and directives we have just received from the Archdiocese which are now going into effect for us here at St. Mark:

- Effective immediately, and until further notice, all public Sunday and weekday Masses have been suspended.
 Along with the Masses, all other liturgical celebrations or gatherings of people of any kind at the church are also suspended.
- The Archbishop's dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass is still in effect until further notice. This
 applies to all the faithful of the Archdiocese.
- The suspension of all other parish meetings and activities that was put in place this past Friday, March 13th, remains in place. The parish office will remain open remotely. The parish staff will not be on site, but can receive phone calls and emails. Mail and deliveries are still being accepted at the parish office.

During this time, we will be offering as much as we can on our website for you to connect to St. Mark virtually. This will include links to live-streamed and recorded Masses, reflections with the daily Mass readings, and my Sunday homilies. We will also post special prayers so that we can be united in our spiritual lives, even as we are physically apart during this time. I encourage you to check our website www.stmarkindy.org for updates daily.

In order to ensure for the care of our elderly and most vulnerable parishioners, we are asking all parishioners to be vigilant in maintaining telephone contact with any of our senior members that they know. Please take this period of social distancing seriously, and remain home and separate from others except for necessity. You are of course encouraged to continue your daily routine of prayer and spiritual growth. It is as important as ever to unite ourselves with our God each and every day! However, for the good of our community and the vulnerable, we are being asked to do this from home for the time being.

Please know that while Mass is not being celebrated publicly, I am still celebrating Mass each and every day for our scheduled intentions and for the parish as a whole. It greatly saddens me to have to celebrate Mass each day in your absence, and I know it will be difficult for so many of you who cherish the opportunity to come together in prayer and receive the Lord in the Eucharist; however, I truly do believe that we will all be spiritually united during this extraordinary time.
