
#### **SPRED**

Ash Wednesday is February 17th Mass times will be 6:30 AM, 8:15 AM and 7:00 PM

The 8:15 AM and 7:00 PM will be live streamed on YouTube.

The COVID precautions given to parishes by the Archdiocese of Indianapolis include that Ashes will be sprinkled on the top of people's heads instead of the sign of the cross on the forehead.

Sprinkling ashes on the top of people's heads, rather than marking foreheads with ashes, is the customary practice at the Vatican and in Italy. Given the spread of the coronavirus, the practice has the advantage of not requiring the priest and ministers to touch multiple people.




