

#### **DIVINE MERCY**

Today, we are celebrating Divine Mercy Sunday. In the penitential rite at every Mass, we use the word Mercy. Lord have Mercy, Christ have Mercy, Lord have Mercy.

What are we asking for when we ask for God's mercy? First and foremost, we are asking for forgiveness for our sins and transgressions, "what we have done, and what we have failed to do."

The word Mercy in scripture is not as common as we might think. It does not appear in John's Gospel. Luke's Gospel has the most references to the word. It's used in his telling of the stories of the Good Samaritan and the Prodigal Son. In today's Scriptures, we hear the word is in 1 Peter which praises God for showing us Mercy by giving us new birth through the Resurrection.

What it comes down to is that Mercy (eleos in Greek) is an action, not an emotion. It is Divine action at work in us, Christ's ultimate sacrifice for the forgiveness of sins. If we look to Luke's human examples, we see Mercy was what the Samaritan did as he risked his life and put his goods at the service of a person in need. In the Father and son story, the Father practiced Mercy by embracing his son and throwing a party for him. Mercy, therefore, carries the themes of forgiveness, compassion, and reconciliation. It has both divine and human characteristics.


Jesus instructs us to, "Be merciful just as your Heavenly Father is merciful." cf Luke 6:36

Praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet is a beautiful way for us to express the joy of the Easter Season in recognition of Christ's great act of Love and Mercy. We ask for God's Mercy for ourselves and for the whole world; to "look kindly on us and increase your Mercy within us."

Why not try praying it, particularly during this holy Easter Season? There are printed and audio version everywhere which you can easily access.

May God continue to lavishly shower us with his Divine Mercy, and may we become increasingly aware of the grace we have received to show his Mercy to others.


