Deacon Nick's Corner

Invite the  
Lord In!

In reading (or listening to) the Gospel today about two of Jesus' disciples on a journey to a nearby village, does it sound a little like the disciples might be confused or downcast about the things which had happened in Jerusalem? They had hoped for the long-awaited Jewish Messiah who would free the Israelites from their subjugation to Rome. The events of Good Friday, though, had dashed their hopes! They – and probably many others – seem to have given up. The disciples had left everything to follow Jesus, and now they were walking back to their old lives gravely disappointed.

Have you ever felt that way about your faith life? I know I have and, figuratively, I also have gone “...to a village seven miles from...” faith, being much disheartened by life and full of doubt about what was next!

Jesus – unrecognized by the disciples – joined them as they walked home and inquired about their discussions. It's almost a little humorous when Cleopas asks Jesus if he's “...the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know of the things that have taken place there in these days...” (**emphasis** is mine). You can almost imagine Cleopas adding, “Where have you been?” ... and then a smile on Jesus' face before he begins opening their eyes by interpreting the Old Testament references and prophecies concerning the Messiah. As they approach Emmaus, however, it seems that Jesus will continue the journey without the disciples so that their discussions would be curtailed. Listening to Jesus, Cleopas and his friend had gradually begun to feel their heavy hearts rekindled with hope that the women's tales of an empty tomb and a miraculous resurrection were not as crazy as it sounded! Perhaps they weren't foolish and slow of heart to believe all that God had written, after all!

But then, the disciples did an extremely wise thing and, probably, the one correct thing they did in this story: they urged him to stay with them at their home! We might miss what seems an insignificant offer of lodging in the larger parameters of this story, but it is when Jesus “...took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them...” that they actually recognized their guest! Can you imagine their surprise, the emotion they must have felt having the Lord with them even if only for THAT moment? It must have been absolutely amazing, don't you think?

In my own life, my faith has been challenged a few times. It happens to many of us. For me, Jesus came in the guise of a Billy Graham film about a college student who was without faith and lost, a bit like I was back in the mid-1970s. It was only by accident that my roommate at the time and our girlfriends had gone to see the movie – we thought it was a romance! I don't even remember the title now, but in the 2 hours of that film, Jesus walked with me, and explained things to me, and created such a great longing in my heart to really know him, that my life was forever changed! That was my Emmaus walk..., but I still had to ask him to come into my heart and relight my faith. There have been some detours from then to now, but the Lord has always been with me through the good and the bad times.

Jesus blessed Cleopas and his friend, all the disciples, and all of us, but we must offer ourselves to him and invite him into the home of our hearts. If we truly wish to follow Christ, he will love us and lead us as no one on Earth ever could! So, be willing to open the door and invite the Divine Mercy into your life!
