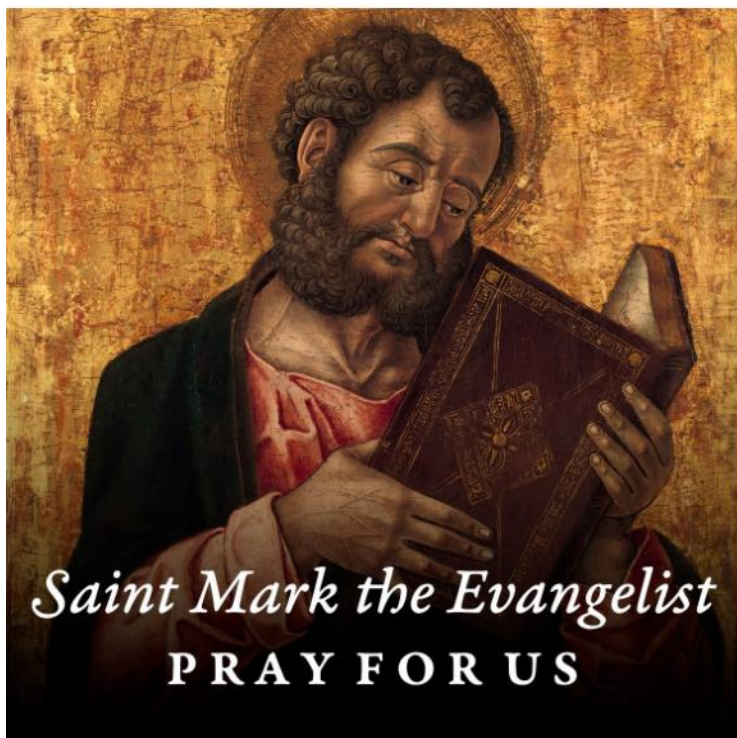


Hello Everyone,
