Fr. Tim's Pastors Corner

Hello Everyone,

Happy Solemnity of the Ascension! As we celebrate Jesus ascending to the right hand of His Father, we also prepare ourselves for the coming celebration of the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and the birthday of the Holy Catholic Church! There is certainly much to celebrate in our liturgical calendar right now.

I also want to draw your attention to a new feature in our narthex. On the north side of the narthex, near the Mary Lynn Cavanaugh welcome desk, there is a drop box with “suggestion” cards in it. This is an opportunity for those, especially who are not comfortable with email, or wish to remain anonymous, to ask any question or make any suggestion that they want me to see. The cards say “suggestions,” and suggestions are certainly welcome. But the cards can also be used to ask me theological questions that can be answered periodically in “Ask Father Tim” editions of the Pastor’s Corner. It is also a good place to state a concern if you feel it needs to be addressed.

For example, a few months ago there was a lot of questions around the sidewalks that were put in on the north parking lot attached to the asphalt that

didn’t seem to serve much purpose. I addressed this at Mass so that people who were wondering why we spent the money to put those in, when they don’t add much to the accessibility, and there are already existing crumbling sidewalks that we need to repair when we can afford it. The answer was simple, the city required them due to the new building space, with no flexibility on spending the money to fix already existing and damaged sidewalks. When serious questions or rumors come to my attention that can be addressed to quell concerns, it is good for me to know, and be able to answer them. And of course, I always love answering theological questions when they come up as well. I might not be able to answer every question and concern that comes in, but I will do my best to answer those most pertinent that I am able to.

Certainly, email or phone calls can still be used to ask questions or make suggestions, but I understand that some are not comfortable with email, and some prefer anonymity, so this drop box provides one more opportunity to make your questions, suggestions, and concerns known!

A reminder if you are 72 years or older and have an IRA account, the IRS requires you to take a RMD (required minimum distribution) or face a taxable penalty.

One way of getting around that penalty is to include the RMD as part of your charitable giving to St. Mark the Evangelist Catholic Church. Not only will this help you avoid an IRS penalty, it may also qualify you for a tax deduction for charitable giving.

## ST. MARK CATHOLIC SCHOOL

Hello Saint Mark  
Community,

School safety, as it should be, is of the utmost importance to us. We have made many updates and changes this year to ensure we are doing all we can to keep our students and staff safe. I wanted to take a moment to share many of those updates with you.



**Updates from Mrs. Kocher!**

First, we have a lot of support from local authorities as well as a safety team that is working on our protocols. This past summer we had a full safety assessment performed by the IMPD which identified a few vulnerabilities. We have addressed or have plans in motion to address those identified vulnerabilities including a brand new walkie talkie system for communication in an emergency. Some of our classroom doors and door knobs were identified as a vulnerability in our safety assessment. Therefore, we are replacing some of the classroom doors and all of the door knobs.

We had active shooter training for all staff this past fall given by the Indiana State Police. We have practiced drills for fire, tornado, and lockdown procedures with all students and staff. The Indianapolis Fire Department joined us for a fire drill and helped identify any changes needed to our evacuation plans.

We have updated our camera system, which is more reliable and eliminated numerous blind spots. We are also in the process of updating our door access system, which will also tighten accessibility. In addition, in the near future an all new, updated emergency alerting and paging system is being installed on the entire Saint Mark property.

Finally, we have changed multiple internal procedures including how and who is reported on attendance as well as how visitors are entering the building. We will be asking IMPD and the Fire Department to come back when construction is complete to reassess our property for any new vulnerabilities.

I assure you, we are proactive and diligent on safety procedures and protocols. Though no safety plan can guarantee absolute security, we continuously plan and adjust safety procedures with assistance of local authorities.
