Hello Everyone,


This Sunday is an incredibly important celebration for our Church. The Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi), which is always the Second Sunday after Pentecost, and the Sunday after Trinity Sunday, dates all the way back to the 13th century when St. Thomas Aguinas proposed the idea to Pope Urban IV as a way to encourage Catholics to be reminded of the True Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and the gift of the Mass, which grants us access to this Sacrament. This is still the purpose of Corpus Christi Sunday today; it is a reminder to us of the Source and Summit of our entire Christian life and faith. This year, we celebrate this feast with even more vigor, as the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have established a three year "Eucharistic Revival" to encourage a revival of Eucharistic devotion and fervor in our country. This will culminate next summer with a Eucharistic Congress here in Indianapolis, expected to be attended by many thousands of Catholics from around the country. Here at St. Mark this Sunday, we will celebrate the traditional practice of a Eucharistic procession after the 4:30pm, 9:30am, and 11:45am Masses. These "mini processions" are a reminder to us of our devotion to the Eucharist, following where Christ leads, and bringing Christ from the church building, into the world. I hope you are inspired by our small expression of this most important element of the practice of our faith!

On another note, I also want to announce an exciting development inside our church building. If you have watched any of Rusty's construction updates for the new building on YouTube, you will have noticed a very nice statue nook in the new Parish Life Center's lobby, adorned by the old Greek style concrete columns and arch from the previous Parish Center (the Convent before it became the offices). This nook is a perfect place to put our St. Mark Statue, which was donated to our parish years ago by the Francis and Mary Burkhardt Family. That statue will be moved to the new lobby, which means our side chapel in the church will be vacant. Due to the generosity of a parish in our Archdiocese (All Saints in Dearborn County), we have acquired a statue for very little cost to replace St. Mark in that chapel. The side chapel will now be a Sacred Heart Chapel, and a very nice statue of the Sacred Heart of Jesus will soon be placed in there. I hope you are able to stop in and be inspired by this statue, which is meant to remind of us Jesus's love and mercy through the devotion to the Sacred Heart.

Finally, I want to thank everyone who placed a question in the new box in the narthex, as of now I have enough of these questions to devote an entire Pastor's Corner to answering them, which will be coming next week.

EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL




ARCHDIOCESE OF INDIANAPOLIS Eucharistic Revival 22-25

As some of you may remember, last year there was a huge procession in downtown Indianapolis for Corpus Christi. This year for Corpus Christi each parish was encouraged to hold their own Eucharistic Processions. These two events correspond with the Eucharistic Revival that is happening in the United States.

The National Eucharistic Revival is a movement to restore understanding and devotion to the Great Mystery and the Source and Summit of the Catholic Faith by helping us renew our worship of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. This revival has different phases: this past year was the Year of Diocesan Revival and this next year is the Year of Parish Revival. This is all leading up to a National Eucharistic Congress that will be hosted here in Indianapolis June 17-21, 2024!
