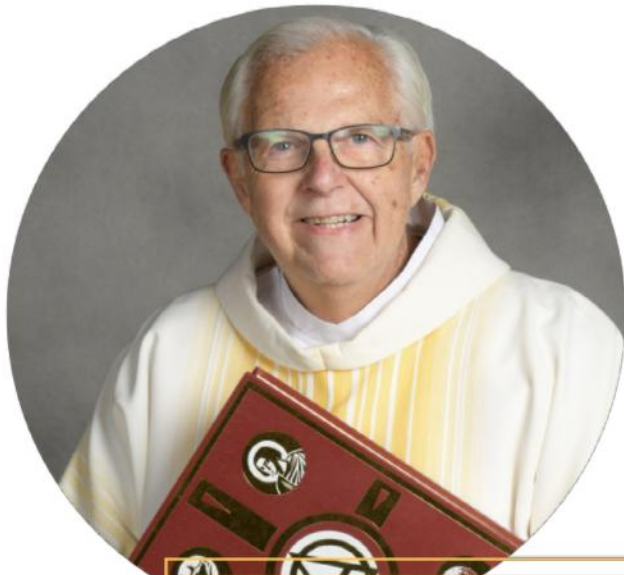
### Policy Regarding Firearms at St. Mark Catholic Church

**For this week's Eucharistic Revival Update, let us pray together the official prayer of the Revival:**

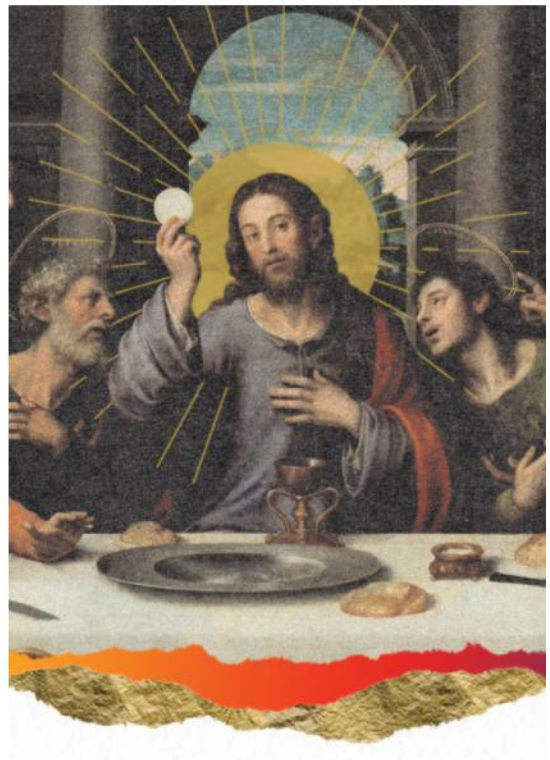
Lord Jesus Christ,
