Where/What are the SVdP BLUE BOXES ?

- * The first winterwear we think of as days gets shorter and definitely chillier...are coats, hats/gloves, and boots, but the need actually goes much deeper. Skin deep to be precise. Long underwear, thick socks, sweaters and turtlenecks. Winter-worthy shoes (especially for kids) and toboggans (stocking) hats are all candidates for a BLUE BOX donation.
- * The Mission 27 Stores really need all kinds of winter clothing, especially for children. You can get items to the Distribution Center/ Mission 27 stores by dropping donations at one of the SVdP BLUE BOXES. Seven of the forty citywide SVdP BLUE BOXES are located nearby. They are the perfect way to donate clothing and SOFT stuff like sheets and blankets anytime!
- * BLUE BINS are located at Roncalli HS, St. Jude, St. Barnabas, St. Roch, Good Shepherd, Holy Name, and OLG. Try to pack neatly, and recruit someone with a bit of muscle because the 'door' you pull down is kinda heavy. They are emptied regularly by a volunteer van crew.

It is a very efficient way to get clothing to the Distribution Center.
