Hello Everyone,


I hope that you had a wonderful Christmas and a very happy New Year! Our liturgies for the birth of Christ on Christmas, The Holy Family last weekend, and Mary Mother of God on New Year's Day were beautiful celebrations of our faith here at St. Mark. This sacred time gives us a chance to reflect on the most important part of our lives: the faith.

Now we have come to the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord. This is the day in which we celebrate the nations coming to adore Christ, represented by the three magi. It is a beautiful solemnity in which the entire world celebrates its redemption which was prepared for us through the Jewish people. 


Epiphany House Blessing

The traditional date of Epiphany is January 6, but in the United States it is celebrated on the Sunday between January 2 and January 8. This Sunday, January 7 we will celebrate Epiphany. This is a beautiful tradition and a holy way to begin the New Year.

It is a long-held Catholic tradition to bless one's home on (or near) the celebration of the Epiphany by using chalk to write a special inscription above the home's entrance. The Letters C, M, and B have two meanings. They are the initials of the traditional names of the three magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. They are also the first letters of the Latin words Christus mansionem benedicat, "May Christ bless the house." The + signs represent the cross, and 2024 is the year.

The House Blessing prayer and a piece of blessed chalk can be found in baskets in the Narthex.

When you have completed this House Blessing, you can return the blessed chalk to the baskets located in the Narthex.

Prayers of the Holy Rosary: The Apostles Creed We begin all prayer "In the name of the Father and of the Son and



of the Holy Spirit". This is followed with the Apostles Creed as we hold the Crucifix. It is a holy summary of all our Christian truths.

"It is a prayer that has great merit because faith is the root, foundation and beginning of all Christian virtues, of all eternal virtues, and of all prayers that are pleasing to God. "Anyone who comes to God must believe," and the greater his faith the more merit his prayer will have, the more powerful it will be, and the more it will glorify God." (The Secret of the Rosary by St. Louis de Montfort)

The first words of the Creed, "I believe in God," are very powerful if prayed with devotion and conviction of the truths we profess even if those truths are still a mystery to us.
