A LETTER FROM FATHER ERIC



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, Greetings. I hope this finds all of you well. I particularly want to wish all of our mothers a very happy and special Mother's Day. I hope it proves to be an enjoyable day, full of goodness and

blessing. In his mindfulness and care for his people, and in the comfort he offers to the suffering, the Lord compares himself to a mother who remembers and cares for her children. It is good for us to remember those who have shown us generous love and affection, and on this day in particular, to remember the ways in which our mothers have helped us to understand a bit more what God's love looks like. May our hearts be filled with gratitude for this witness and may God hold all of our mothers in his compassionate love.

This weekend is the final weekend of our Sunday Children's Catechesis for the year. As we step back from this ministry for the summer, I want to stop and say how grateful I am for all who assist with this very important ministry of providing catechesis and faith formation for our young people. I appreciate the commitment of our catechists, those who guide our

young people in sacramental preparation and for the assistance of so many others that give generously of themselves. I also want to thank our parents and caregivers that value the importance of this formation and faithfully bring their children here to grow more deeply in their love of God and neighbor. It is a privilege to walk with families in their own ministry of witnessing to Christ in the home and here in worship. I pray that all have a great summer and an opportunity for rest and refreshment.

This weekend Jesus tells us that our love for Christ finds expression in keeping his commandments. It is a refrain that appears many times in John's gospel. I'm not sure most of us would associate love with commandments, but I do think there is a relationship between obedience and love. All relationships make certain demands. They require things like time, fidelity, generosity, mutuality, and at times, seeking the good of the other over my own immediate desires or self gratification.

Our relationship with God is no different. Loving God means conforming my own will to His. It means following His ways, trusting that because of His love, His ways lead to life. To love God is to choose God, even over myself. Within all of this is obedience, in which I allow Christ's commandments to shape my very self.

In this we have hope, because in the same reading, Jesus promises not to leave us orphans. In loving him, we will see him, and in seeing him, we will know eternal life.


On a recent Saturday morning, more than 1,000 families shopped at our SVdP 30th Street Food Pantry. That's a lot of grocery carts within a four-hour period...but not unusual these days. On World Food Day, Pope Leo XIV, addressed our shared responsibility to one another, stating, "...only through sincere and constant cooperation can we build fair and accessible food security for all. Only by joining hands can we build a dignified future in which food security is reaffirmed as a right and not a privilege."

When it comes to food assistance, the Indianapolis Southside takes "Joining hands" to heart. In addition to the HUNGER INC. pantry on East Epler and our newer neighbor SERVANTS HEART at Madison and Edgewood, there are more than 15 smaller pantry options in the 46227 Zipcode. ASSISTIVE LISTENING AVAILABLE

Good news! St. Mark has recently installed a new adaptive hearing system to help parishioners who use hearing aids or other devices. This system is called Listen Wi-Fi, it uses your smartphone to connect to the Guest Wi-Fi Network at St. Mark. Once connected to the Wi-Fi Network and have the app installed, you can stream the audio from Mass directly into your hearing aids.



1. Connect to the St. Mark Guest Wi-Fi network, password is **Lions2022**
2. Download the free **Listen WIFI** app from the Apple App Store or Google Play. (It is a blue icon with white headphones, see the example below).
3. Open the app, and allow the app access to your Bluetooth, and location while use the app. Once loaded correctly, press play on Channel 1 and the audio from the churches microphones will start to play in your Bluetooth enabled device (hearing aids).
4. **Tips & Tricks:** On your hearing aids, while at mass, turn down the sensitivity to the room ambiance, so the church microphones become the dominant sound.




