A LETTER FROM FATHER ERIC



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Memorial Day Weekend. I hope this finds all of you well. For those of you who have a holiday weekend, I hope today and tomorrow are relaxing, safe and enjoyable. As we join in remembering those who sacrificed of themselves in service to our

country, let us pray also for our service men and women serving throughout the world. Memorial Day, I think, also invites us to reflect on those traits of character that ennoble us and make us more fully human: sacrifice, commitment, service, community and generosity. In remembering those who served, let us also work to cultivate those things that make us better people, and which helps to build up the common good and sustain peace.

As I mentioned last weekend much is taking place here on campus this summer, with several significant projects related to our buildings and grounds. In addition to a number of other activities, we will have a rummage sale next weekend, with Vacation Bible School taking place the following week. On June 6th we will celebrate the ordinations of Deacon Khaing Thu and Deacon Timothy Khuishing to the priesthood with Masses of Thanksgiving here at St. Mark. The Myanmar community will also host a celebration of Parents Day, in July, here at our parish. There will be much going on here this summer and there is much to be grateful for.

Today we celebrate the great Feast of Pentecost and the gift of the Holy Spirit to the disciples. On this day, as the disciples hid in fear behind the locked doors of the Upper Room, God's Spirit descended, casting out this fear and throwing open the doors. So filled with grace and the power of the Spirit, some in the crowd were convinced they had had too much to drink. It was a pivotal moment. No longer would the disciples hide in fear or seek the security of a closed room. From this day forward, they went out and boldly proclaimed the Good News of Jesus Christ and his Passion and Resurrection. On that day of Pentecost, the disciples took up their mission, and in doing so the Church herself was born.

It is for the Proclamation of the Gospel and the salvation of souls that the Church exists. In his final instructions to his disciples, Jesus sends them forth with the words: "You are witnesses to these things." Evangelization is the very heart of the Church's identity. It is our mission and purpose to point not to ourselves, but in all things to point to the person of Christ.

Perhaps it is good this Pentecost Sunday for each of us to step back and ask how we have responded to this call. Have others been invited to find Christ through our lives and witness? Do we share with others the great gift that we have found? Do we encourage others to come to Mass, to hear God's voice in silence, to respond to Christ's call to conversion, to serve God by ministering to his people? Do we pray for those who God might be calling to fill our pews? Do our lives cause people to question, to desire our hope, to be attracted to our joy?

It is the Holy Spirit that enables us to witness and faithfully respond to this call. Through the Spirit's gift of grace we are endowed with wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord. Such gifts fill us with conviction and passion and lend authenticity to our words. By allowing ourselves to be moved by the Spirit, we participate in the divine work of renewing the face of the earth and being a witness of hope, faith and charity.
