Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Agreement

Thank you for choosing the EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer) Plan! Here is how it works. First, fill out the form completely and legibly. You may authorize 1 or 2 monthly withdrawals to be made directly from your checking or savings account. Your funds will be withdrawn on the 1st, 15th or 25th as you designate.. If any payment dates fall on a weekend or holiday, the withdrawal will be made on the next business day. Proof of payment will appear on your bank statement. You will have a choice whether the withdrawal is to be used as a stewardship contribution (also known as "church dues" or church support) AND/OR another need at St. Mary that you wish to support.
