

CHRISTIAN WITNESS STATEMENT

From the code of Canon Law: A baptized person who belongs to another Christian community may be admitted only as a "Christian witness" (not a godparent) provided that there is at least one Roman Catholic godparent who fulfills the above criteria. A non-baptized person cannot be a witness (Cans. 872-874; Catechism of the Catholic Church 1255).
