Pastor's Message

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

May the Joy of Easter grace fill your heart!

"Surrexit Christus, spes mea" –
"Christ, my hope, has risen" (Easter Sequence).

These are the words proclaimed by Mary Magdalene in the hymn, as she was chosen to be the first witness to the risen Christ on Easter morning. She then ran to the other disciples announcing the Good News: "I have seen the



Lord!" (Jn 20:18) Having journeyed through the desert of Lent and Covid, and prayed through the sorrowful days of the Passion, now come to Easter, shouting with all of the Christians thr: "He has risen! He has truly risen!"

Every single Christian is invited to live the experience of Mary Magdalene. It involves a living encounter which changes our lives definitively: the encounter with the Man-God who lets us experience the fullness of the Father's love, goodness and truth, which frees us from evil not in a superficial or fleeting way, but radically sets our soul free, healing us completely and redeeming us. This is why Mary Magdalene calls Jesus "my hope": He was the one who allowed her to be reborn, who opened a new horizon and gave her a completely new future, a possibility of a new life of goodness and freedom from evil. "Christ my hope" means that all my deepest yearnings for goodness find in Christ a real possibility of fulfilment: with Him I have true hope for a life that is good, full and eternal, for God Himself has drawn near to us, even sharing our humanity. Today let us welcome that grace into our life which can transform us by enabling us to die to our old life and begin a brand-new one.


