

SAINT OF THE WEEK SAINT JUNIPERO SERA

Miguel Jose Serra was born on the island of Majorca on November 24, 1713. He entered Franciscan Order at which time he took the name Junipero.



Ordained in 1737, he taught philosophy and theology at the University of Padua until 1749.

On January 1, 1751, at the age of thirty-seven, he landed in Mexico City and spent the rest of his life working for the conversion of the peoples of the New World. In 1768, Father Serra was head of a group of Franciscans tasked with evangelizing California, then part of New Spain. He established his first mission at San Diego in 1769. He would go on to help found another eight missions up the coast through the San Francisco Bay Area that would eventually grow to 21 missions all together. In 1769, he established his headquarters near the Presidio (Garrison) of Monterey, but soon moved a few miles south to establish Mission San Carlos Borromeo de Carmelo in today's Carmel, California.

A tireless worker, Serra was in large part responsible for the foundation and spread of the Church on the West Coast of the United States when it was still mission territory.

Father Serra passed away on August 28, 1784 at the age of 70 near Monterey. He was beatified by Pope John Paul II on September 25, 1988. A statue of Father Serra stands in the rotunda of the U.S. Capitol. He was canonized on September 23, 2015, by Pope Francis. His feast day is celebrated on July 1.
