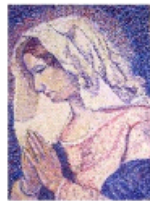

SAINT OF THE WEEK

SAINT CAMILLUS DE LELLIS

Camillus de Lellis was born on May 25, 1550, at Bucchianico, Kingdom of Naples. His mother, Camilla Compelli de Laureto, was nearly fifty when she gave birth to him. His father was an officer in both the Neapolitan and French royal armies. Camillus had his father's temper and, due to his mother's age and retiring nature, she felt unable to control him as he grew up, his father was seldom home.



Camillus at 16, joined his father in the Venetian army and fought in a war against the Turks. He was addicted to gambling, and by 1574 was penniless in Naples. Camillus took work as a laborer at the Capuchin friary at Manfredonia; he was constantly plagued, however, by an open wound he received while in the army, which would not heal. Despite his aggressive nature and excessive gambling, the guardian of the friary saw a better side to his nature, and continually tried to bring that out in him. Eventually, the friar's exhortations penetrated his heart and he had a religious conversion in 1575. He then entered the Capuchin novitiate. His leg wound, however, had continued to plague him and was declared incurable by the physicians, thus he was denied admission to that Order.

Camillus moved to Rome and devoted himself to caring for the sick. He became director of St. Giacomo Hospital. He received permission from his confessor (St. Philip Neri) to be ordained and decided, with two

companions, to found his own congregation, the Ministers of the Sick (the Camellians), dedicated to the care of the sick. They ministered to the sick of Holy Ghost Hospital in Rome, enlarged their facilities in 1585, founded a new house in Naples in 1588, and attended the plague-stricken aboard ships in Rome's harbor and in Rome. In 1591, the Congregation was made into an order to serve the sick by Pope Gregory XIV, and in 1591 and 1605, Camillus sent members of his order to minister to wounded troops in Hungary and Croatia, becoming the first field medical unit.

Gravely ill for many years, Camillus resigned as superior of the Order in 1607 and passed away in Rome on July 14, 1614. He was canonized in 1746 by Pope Benedict XIV and declared patron of the sick, with St. John of God, by Pope Leo XIII, and patron of nurses and nursing groups by Pope Pius XI. His feast day is July 14.

FRANCISCAN VOCATIONS

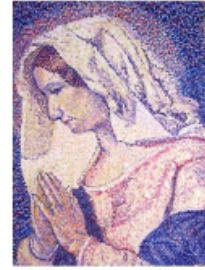

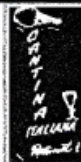
