Pastor's Message

Feast of Il Perdono

On August 2nd, St Leonard's Parish invites you to experience the grace of celebrating the feast of "Il Perdono" (the Pardon). This is a great gift from heaven that was granted to St Francis himself in 1216, when he petitioned Pope Honorius for a special privilege to all those who would visit the little chapel of the Porziuncula, which means "little portion", a beloved Church dedicated to



St Mary of the Angels, and home to all Franciscans. This special 805 year old Franciscan tradition has its origin from a legend about what happened to St Francis one night while he was praying on how to save souls. A bright light shone and an angel suddenly appeared and told him that the Son of God in company with his Virgin Mother and a host of angels had visibly descended into the Portiuncula church and would permit him to appear before His throne of grace. Without delay the saint ran to the little church and found there all as the angel had told him. Full of holy

awe he threw himself upon his face and adored Jesus most profoundly. Jesus looked graciously upon him and said to him: "Francis you are very zealous for the good of souls. Ask me what you want for their salvation."

St. Francis was rapt in ecstasy before Jesus. When he regained his courage he said: "Lord, I a miserable sinner beg You to concede an indulgence to all those who enter this church, who are truly contrite and have confessed their sins. And I beg Blessed Mary, your Mother, intercessor of man, that she intercede on behalf of this grace." Our Lady at once began to beseech her son on behalf of Francis. Jesus answered: "It is a very great thing that which you ask Me; but you are worthy of even greater things, Friar Francis, and greater things you will have. So I accept your request, but I want you to go to my Vicar, to whom I have given the power to bind and loose in Heaven and on earth, to ask him on my behalf for this indulgence."

In order to make this indulgence more accessible to the faithful, the Popes subsequently extended it to all the churches of the Franciscans.

We will begin our celebration with Mass on August 1st at 12:00 noon and the following day we will have confession available from 10:00 am until mass at 12:05 pm and then another mass at 6:30 pm. There is a special plenary indulgence (a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins) offered only once a year to all the faithful who visit a Franciscan Church or parish church and follow the conditions.

To receive this privilege (for yourself or for someone else – living or deceased), in addition to the visit, one must:

1) Go to Confession to be in God's grace (during eight days before or after),

2) Participate in the Holy Mass and receive the Eucharist

3) Recite the Apostles Creed, Our Father and a prayer for the Pope's Intent
