Dear Friends:

This past Saturday, August 14th, an earthquake struck Haiti causing enormous damage and resulting in a significant loss of life.

Catholic Relief Services (CRS) announced that it "is sending teams to provide clean water, sanitation, shelter and emergency supplies in response to a major earthquake that struck southern Haiti early Saturday morning. While the severity of the damage is still being determined, with communications down in parts of the country, hundreds of deaths have already been reported as well as extensive damage to buildings and homes."

Recognizing the suffering of the Haitian people and growing need for assistance, Cardinal Seán has asked that a special collection for Catholic Relief Services and the Church in Haiti be taken the weekends of August 21-22 or August 28-29 in all parishes in the Archdiocese of Boston.

The parishes of the Archdiocese of Boston have consistently stepped forward during times of natural disasters to assist our brothers and sisters in other parts of the world. Following the 2010 earthquake in Haiti, where CRS reports "more than 300,000 people were killed and another 1.3 million left without homes", the parishioners of the Archdiocese generously raised more than \$2 million for relief efforts.

From a Parishioner

Home is a rare find. It can be cultivated almost anywhere, given enough time, but rarely is it given, ready-made.

For the last 2 1/2 months, I've had the good fortune of spending my summer here in the neighborhood, living at Saint Joseph's Home for Artisans on Tileston Street. I know that you, as long-time parishioners, know this more than I do, but God lives in the North End in a way not found in other American cities anymore, and Saint Leonard's is the anchor. Here, faith and tradition still exist together in a way that is interesting, and right, and just, inseparable from each other. God is present here in the commitment to (and stubbornness about) both old customs and new ideas.

I am particularly lucky, among the other residents on Tileston Street, to have been integrated into Parish life through a fortuitous stint as an administrative assistant in the parish office.

I have treasured things that I didn't know I could have an affection for, office humor, trying to pronounce every Italian name during the Mass intentions, neighborhood gossip, and hours of bookkeeping and filing set to the sounds of the rat pack, and most of all, the people who I have been surrounded by. I have experience joy and love here. A couple of weeks ago, I had to fly to Chicago, and Maryann texted me at six in the morning to ask if I had arrived all right.

My deepest thanks to John, Janine, Maryann, Father Michael, Father Federico, Charlie, Brother Charles, Lennie, Ben and Richard, Anthony, Antonio, Toni, Camille, and every person I've been privileged to meet. God gave me a gift, and I am grateful for this home.
