#### **Gospel Reflection**

Today's reading is part of the instructions Jesus gives to his disciples after he has commissioned them to proclaim the approaching Kingdom of heaven (10:1-42). As we already know, Matthew addressed a predominantly Jewish-Christian community, for whom Jesus embodied the fulfillment of the Old Testament. His Gospel is divided into five long discourses that remind us of the Pentateuch, the five books of Moses. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus is the new Moses, the new Lawgiver, and the new Teacher. At the time this Gospel was written (c.85), the early Christian communities were suffering persecution and some were losing their faith in the face of opposition. In this brief text, the phrase, "Do not fear," appears 3 times. With these words, Jesus encouraged the disciples and attacked the fears that could make them abandon their mission. Jesus assured them that their persecutors could destroy the body but never the soul. The coming of the Reign of God was inevitable and fear must not prevent the disciples from proclaiming it.

Today's reading offers three significant messages:

- Fear cannot prevent us from proclaiming the gospel and its demands.
- Jesus promises that we will never be alone in our efforts to do what is right.
- The final judgment before God will be based on the disciples' faithfulness to Jesus during the controversies that are part of their mission.
