ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (OCIA) is the process of welcoming new members to the Catholic Church. It is intended for adults who have never been baptized or for adults who have been baptized Christian and now wish to practice the faith in the Catholic tradition. It is an ongoing process of formation, catechesis and liturgical rites. Anyone interested is asked to call the rectory to discuss the process.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM... Parents are asked to call the parish office to register for the Baptismal Preparation Meeting and for the baptism of their child. Parents are expected to be participating members of the parish.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE... Couples seeking to be married in the Church are to make arrangements with the pastor six months to one year in advance of their intended wedding date, in order to allow time for marriage preparation. At least one of the engaged should be a registered and practicing member of the parish.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK... The Sacrament of the Sick is for the spiritual comfort, strength and healing of the ill. If there is a need for the sacrament in your family or household, please contact the rectory as soon as possible.

PASTOR'S CORNER

Happy patronal feast day of St. Aloysius Gonzaga, June 21st!

The following prayer is attributed to St. Aloysius, commending himself to the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is displayed on the plaque at our Mary Garden:

“O holy Mary, my Mother, into your blessed trust and special blessing, into your tender mercy, this day, every day of my life and at the hour of my death, I commend my soul and body; to you I entrust all my hopes and consolations, all my trials and miseries, my life and the end of my life, that through your most holy intercession and your merits, all my actions may be ordered and disposed according to your will and that of your divine Son. Amen.”

A relic of St. Aloysius is permanently on display in the reliquary by his statue in the niche to the left of the sanctuary. The relic has been in the possession of our parish since the Jesuits were here, but no certification has been found in our archives or information as to the kind of relic it is.

St. Aloysius is the patron saint of Christian youth and Jesuit scholastics, of whom he was one. He died on June 21st, 1591 at the age of 23, having contracted the plague after valiantly ministering to the sick. As Aloysius lay dying, his mentors were amazed that he felt heaven was so near. His Jesuit mentor Robert Bellarmine, later also a canonized saint, prayed that his student's graces might also be his.

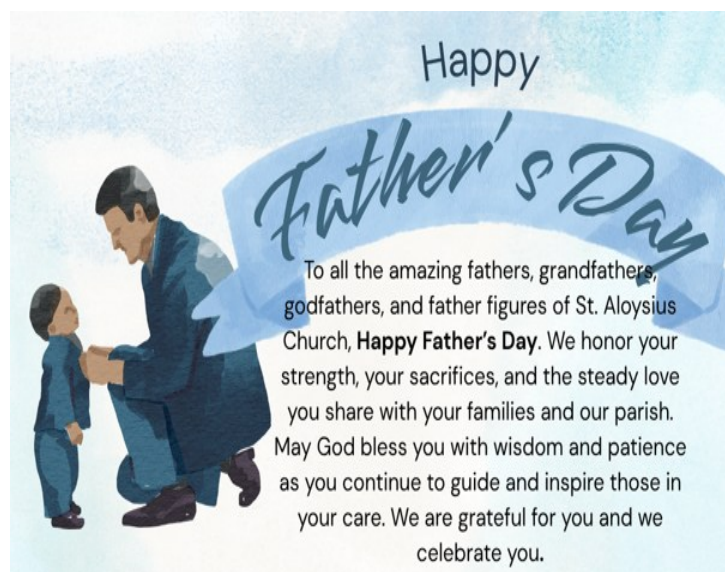

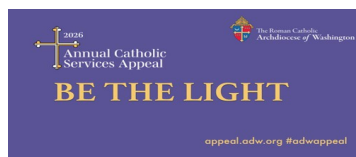

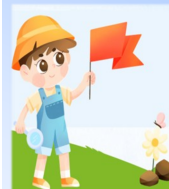
ANNUAL JUNE DRIVE-THRU DINNER

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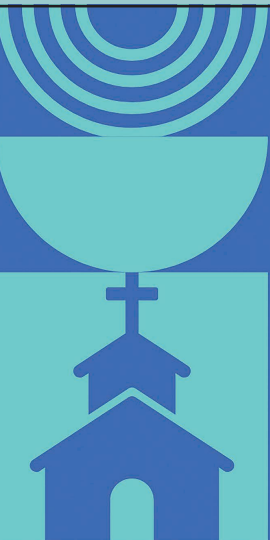
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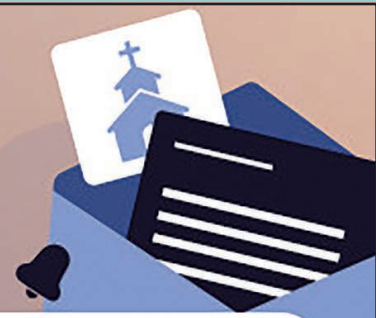
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
