ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (OCIA) is the process of welcoming new members to the Catholic Church. It is intended for adults who have never been baptized or for adults who have been baptized Christian and now wish to practice the faith in the Catholic tradition. It is an ongoing process of formation, catechesis and liturgical rites. Anyone interested is asked to call the rectory to discuss the process.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM... Parents are asked to call the parish office to register for the Baptismal Preparation Meeting and for the baptism of their child. Parents are expected to be participating members of the parish.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE... Couples seeking to be married in the Church are to make arrangements with the pastor six months to one year in advance of their intended wedding date, in order to allow time for marriage preparation. At least one of the engaged should be a registered and practicing member of the parish.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK... The Sacrament of the Sick is for the spiritual comfort, strength and healing of the ill. If there is a need for the sacrament in your family or household, please contact the rectory as soon as possible.

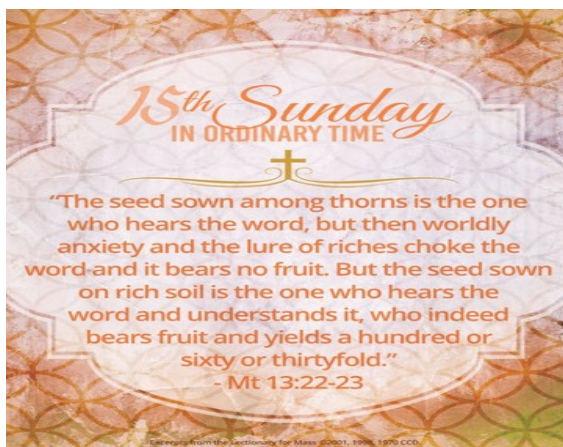
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PASTOR'S CORNER

Planting the Divine Seed

Words signify realities, like virtual seeds springing forth from the mind and becoming real by human follow through. But with God, words virtually are realities. By speaking them, they become real. The prophet Isaiah says of God, "my word shall not return to me void, but shall do my will, achieving the end for which I sent it" (55:11) God's word is like the seed sown in the ground or the acorn that grows into an oak tree. Everything is contained within the seed that in time will become its fulfillment. The seed only needs external things like nutrition and sunlight. In a similar way, God's word planted in our hearts through hearing, reading or praying, can become a reality by our cooperative listening and his divine light of grace opening up our understanding. By obedience to his word, we become more than we are and more whom God calls us to be. Most especially, God plants his Word in us through the Eucharist. Jesus is that fully grown oak tree, man in the perfect state God originally intended for us before sin. When we willingly and intentionally receive him in Holy Communion, we are that fertile soil. The seed of the Word germinates in our souls and we grow in likeness to Jesus. We become that field which "bears fruit and yields a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold" (Matthew 13:23).

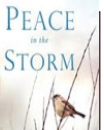

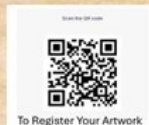

The next open pantry is Sat., July 18/19 9-11AM. Food will be collected after all Masses, July 18/19 Community Sunday. *MANY THANKS* to all who volunteer and donate to support the food pantry!

In today's Gospel, we hear the story of the sower and we know that "some seed fell on rich soil, and produce fruit, a hundred or sixty or thirty fold." This week by putting a gift in the St. Vincent de Paul Poor Box, know that together they will produce fruit a hundred fold. *In the month of June, the St. Aloysius St. Vincent de Paul Society helped 31 people with \$3,818 in cash assistance for rent, utilities and prescriptions. Also, for the month of June the Food Pantry provided assistance to 48 families that shopped at the Pantry, while delivering food to 24 Cedar Lane residents and 7 families while performing home visits. A total of 164 people were served.*



On behalf of St. Vincent de Paul, thank you for your continued support of our Twinning efforts. *Thanks to your generosity, we were able to provide \$896.00 in support to the Conferencia Santa Catalina Labouré in Peru last quarter. 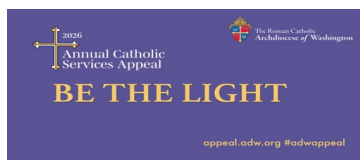

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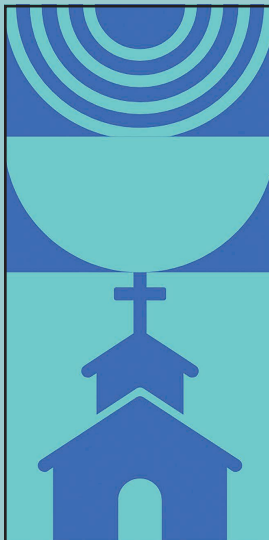
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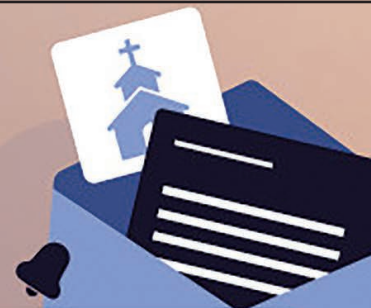


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
