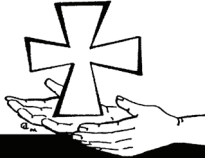

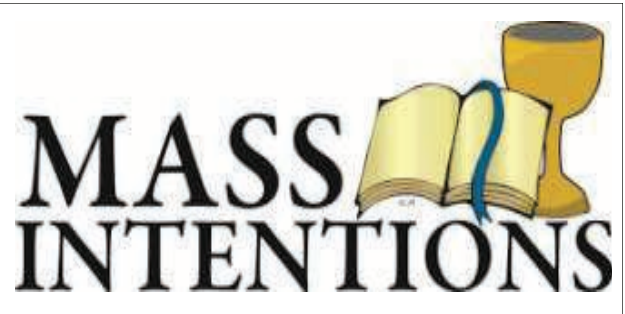

FEAST OF FAITH

The Prayer Over the Offerings

In the liturgy of the 1570 Missal, this prayer was called the "secret" prayer. It was "secret" not because its content was mysterious, but because it was prayed in silence by the priest, who only recited the conclusion aloud: per omnia saecula saeculorum. With the reforms of the Second Vatican Council, we again hear these rich prayers spoken aloud. They remind us to prepare ourselves for what is to happen in the Eucharistic Prayer, for it is not only the bread and wine that will be transformed.

The Prayer Over the Offerings is a prayer for transformation, an expression, in a few words, of all that we hope that the liturgy will accomplish in our lives. We ask God to accept the gifts we present, and to change us even as God hallows the bread and wine. As we listen carefully to the Prayer Over the Offerings, we are reminded of what it is that we seek in the Eucharist: to be made holy; to be drawn closer to God; to come to eternal joy, unity, peace, and salvation.

Dear Parishioners,

SUMMER MASS SCHEDULE ... no 7 am weekday Masses during the months of July and August ... we will resume our usual schedule in September ... PLEASE MARK YOUR CALENDARS.

REGISTRATION FOR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CLASSES ... for children, for teenagers and for adults (RCIA) will resume in August ... watch the bulletin for dates and times.

FINAL CONSTRUCTION ... We have begun the final stages of renovating our Lower Church and rear façade. We hope to have the work done as soon as possible, but as you know when permits and supplies are involved there are bound to be delays. Please bear with us.

NEW AD SPONSORS ... please notice the businesses that are supporting our weekly bulletin ... we are grateful to the many businesses and offices that advertise and support the printing of our Sunday bulletin ... please consider patronizing them and tell them you saw their ad in our Sunday bulletin.

AS ALWAYS ... a reminder about arriving early --- or at least, on time --- for Mass ... Jesus deserves our complete attention from the beginning of the Mass until the end ... on time for the Masses on Saturday at 5:30 pm and Sunday at 7:30 am, 9 am, 10:30 am, and 12 noon.

PARKING ... please be courteous ... do not use two spaces ... do not block other cars ... both parking lots are open --- on Castle Hill and on Purdy Street.

CREMATION ... as Catholics, we have permission of the church to be cremated ... the procedure for the funeral is: WAKE SERVICE WITH THE BODY, FUNERAL MASS WITH THE BODY, CREMATION and burial as soon as possible after the cremation ... we should not save the ashes at home, bring them to the beach or the mountains or leave them in the funeral home ... the ashes are to be treated with respect and dignity like a body and be buried as soon as possible after the cremation.

CONFESSIONS ... We will continue having confessions in English and Spanish available on Wednesdays from 6:00 pm to 6:45 pm with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, in addition to our Saturday confessions schedule.

MASKS ... Mask requirements in church have been lifted for everyone; those who wish to continue to wear a mask may do so at their discretion. We continue encouraging communion received in the hand rather than on the tongue.

MASS FOR THE HEARING IMPAIRED ... The last Sunday of each month we have Mass at 12 noon with sign language ... pass on the word to relatives and friends who might be interested ... sign language is beautiful and inspiring to watch.

MASS INTENTIONS ... you can remember a family member or friend with an intention at a specific Mass come to the rectory for a specific date ... the offering is \$15 and Mass cards are available with each Mass ... the intentions can be for a living or deceased person ... intentions are printed in the bulletin.

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION ... Just a reminder that

we ask that you preferably receive Holy Communion in your hands, by holding out both hands one on top of the other. Also remember that the proper response to the priest before receiving Holy Communion is "Amen," not "Thank you."

BAPTISMS ... all Catholics should be baptized ... parents should be registered in the parish and attending weekly Sunday Mass in order to have the child baptized ... godparents must be practicing Catholics who have received the sacraments of Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation and, if married, married in the church ... godparents must be members of a parish and must be attending weekly Mass ... if you are going to be a godparent, it makes perfect and reasonable sense that you are practicing the faith and that you are a model for the child.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY ... the Catholic Church teaches that marriage is between a man and a woman, a sign of LOVE and LIFE ... Catholics should be married in the church and, if married only civilly, should speak to one of the priests about receiving the sacrament in the Church (called convalidation) ... please know that you are welcome to ask questions and to receive direction and advice about the SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY ... Please remember to secure a date for your wedding before making any arrangements with caterers, limo drivers, family and friends.

FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS ... the usual practice for Catholic burials is a wake service in a funeral home, a Funeral Mass in the parish church, burial of the body or cremains in a cemetery (preferably a Catholic cemetery) ... speak with one of the priests for assistance before a death occurs and speak with a reputable funeral home director about pre-arrangements ... cremains (ashes) are held in the same reverence and respect as a body and so they should be treated carefully, respectfully, reverentially and buried as soon as possible after cremation.

PARISH REGISTRATION ... all members of the parish should be registered and receive parish mailings and envelopes ... if you are an adult (18 years and older), you should register to receive the envelopes and other information from the parish ... you need to be registered in order to receive recommendation letters, financial statements, tuition rates and other parish related issues ... HOW TO REGISTER? Come to the rectory office on Castle Hill Ave.

LATE FOR CHURCH? ... Why? Please resolve to arrive early for Mass, say a prayer, read the Scripture and be ready when we start it will make the Mass more prayerful and meaningful for all. Remember, if you miss the readings, you miss the teachings of Christ. St. Jerome wrote, "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ." Getting to Church on time matters.

VISITING OF THE SICK OR HOMEBOUND ... If you know of anyone who is sick or homebound and would like to receive communion, Please call the rectory to give us your information as well as the information of the person who wishes to receive communion. They must reside in our parish area.

CREMACIÓN ... como católicos, tenemos el permiso de la iglesia para ser cremados ... el procedimiento para el funeral es: **VELORIO CON EL CUERPO, MISA FUNERAL CON EL CUERPO, CREMACIÓN** y entierro lo más pronto posible después de la cremación ... no debemos guardar las cenizas en el hogar, llevar a la playa o la montañas o dejar en la funeraria ... las cenizas deben ser tratadas con respeto y dignidad como un cuerpo y ser enterradas tan pronto como sea posible después de la cremación.

CONFESIONES ... Continuaremos teniendo confesiones los Miércoles de las 6:00 pm a las 6:45 pm con Exposición al Santísimo Sacramento. Esto como adición a nuestro horario de confesiones de los Sábados.

MASCARILLAS ... Se han levantado los requisitos de mascarilla en la iglesia para todos; aquellos que deseen continuar usando una máscara pueden hacerlo a su discreción. Seguimos motivando a recibir la comunión en la mano, en lugar de la lengua.

MISA PARA LAS PERSONAS CON DISCAPACIDAD AUDITIVA ... El último domingo de cada mes tenemos la misa a las 12 del mediodía con el lenguaje de señas ... decir a familiares y amigos que puedan estar interesados ... el lenguaje de señas es hermoso e inspirador de ver.

INTENCIONES DE LA MISA ... usted puede recordar un

miembro de la familia o amigo con una intención en una Misa específica ... venir a la rectoría para una fecha específica ... la ofrenda es \$15 y tarjetas de la Misa están disponibles con cada Misa ... las intenciones pueden ser para una persona viva o difunta ... intenciones son impresas en el boletín, colocados en el altar y mencionadas por el sacerdote en la Misa.

RECEPCIÓN DE LA SANTA COMUNIÓN ... Solo un recordatorio de que le pedimos que preferiblemente reciba la Sagrada Comunión en sus manos, sosteniendo ambas manos una encima de la otra. También recordar que la respuesta apropiada al sacerdote antes de recibir la Sagrada Comunión es "Amén", no "Gracias".

BAUTISMOS ... todos los católicos deben ser bautizados ... padres deben estar registrados en la parroquia y asistiendo a Misa los domingos semanalmente para tener al niño bautizado ... padrinos deben ser católicos practicantes que han recibido los sacramentos de Bautismo, Santa Comunión y Confirmación y, si casado, casado en la iglesia ... padrinos deben ser miembros de una parroquia y deben estar asistiendo a Misa semanalmente ... si va a ser un padrino, hace perfecto sentido y es razonable que usted este practicando la fe y que es un modelo para el niño.

SACRAMENTO DEL MATRIMONIO ... la Iglesia Católica nos enseña que el matrimonio es entre un hombre y una mujer, un signo de AMOR y VIDA ... Los católicos deben casarse en la iglesia y, si es casado sólo civilmente, debe hablar con uno de los sacerdotes acerca de recibir el sacramento en la iglesia (llamado convalidación) ... por favor saber que son bienvenidos para hacer preguntas y recibir dirección y consejos sobre el SACRAMENTO DEL MATRIMONIO ... Por favor recuerde de asegurar la fecha para su ceremonia antes de hacer cualquier arreglos con los proveedores, los conductores de la limosina, la familia y los amigos.

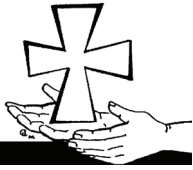
ARREGLOS FUNEBRES ... la práctica usual para entierros católicos es un servicio velatorio en una funeraria, una Misa Fúnebre en la iglesia parroquial, el entierro del cuerpo o restos en un cementerio (preferiblemente un cementerio católico) ... hablar con uno de los sacerdotes para asistencia antes que una muerte ocurra y hablar con un director acreditado de funeraria acerca de arreglos por adelantado ... los restos (las cenizas) deben recibir la misma reverencia y respeto como un cuerpo y por eso deben ser tratados con cuidado, respetuosamente, reverencialmente y enterrados tan pronto como sea posible después de la cremación.

REGISTRACION PARROQUIAL ... todos los miembros de la parroquia debe estar registrados y recibir correspondencia parroquial y los sobres ... si usted es un adulto (18 años y más), debe registrarse para recibir los sobres y otra información de la parroquia ... tienes que estar registrado para poder recibir cartas de recomendación, cartas financieras, precios de matriculación y otros temas relacionados con la parroquia ... **¿CÓMO REGISTRARSE?** Llegar a la rectoría en Castle Hill Ave.

¿TARDE A LA IGLESIA? ... ¿Por qué? Por favor, arreglar llegar temprano a la misa, para orar, leer la Santa Escritura y estar listo cuando empezamos --- hará la misa más devota y significativa para todos ... Recuerde, si usted no oye las lecturas, usted no oye las enseñanzas de Cristo. San Jerónimo escribió, "Ignorar las Escrituras es ignorar a Cristo." Llegar a la iglesia a tiempo es importante.

VISITANDO A LOS ENFERMOS O los CONFINADOS EN LA CASA ... Si usted conoce a alguien que está enfermo o

confinados en la casa que desean recibir la comunión, por favor llame a la rectoría y denos su información así como la información para aquellos que desean recibir la comunión. Deben de residir en nuestra área parroquial.

FIESTA DE LA FE

Plegaria Eucarística

La plegaria es una oración de acción de gracias y santificación. Damos gracias a Dios por todo lo que nos ha dado, pero sobre todo, damos gracias por habernos dado a Jesucristo. Dios se nos ha dado a sí mismo en la persona de Cristo. Por ello, la plegaria comienza reconociendo esa presencia en la asamblea misma: "El Señor esté con ustedes". A partir de ahí, la asamblea, junto con el sacerdote, levanta el corazón a Dios, agradecido. No es una oración privada, sino una oración pública, como la liturgia misma. Es una alabanza que dirigimos a Dios llenos de alegría y gratitud. Es el sacerdote quien, en virtud de su ministerio, dirige esta oración en nombre de toda la comunidad, por "medio de Jesucristo en el Espíritu Santo". Por ello es que la comunidad canta las grandezas de Dios, lo magnifico que ha sido este Dios a lo largo de nuestra historia humana, una y otra vez. Esta oración de plegaria, es la cumbre de la celebración, y por ello la concluimos con el gran Amén, como respuesta a lo que el sacerdote acaba de hacer: "Por Cristo, con él y en él".
