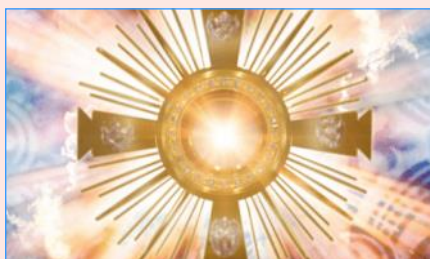
**'Tis ALMOST the season...
